## INTRODUCTION

---

The Azio Levetron L70 LED Backlit Gaming Keyboard is designed to enhance your gaming and typing experience. It features a blue LED backlight for improved visibility in low-light conditions, Multi-Key Rollover for accurate input during intense gaming sessions, and a convenient volume adjustment knob for quick audio control. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your keyboard.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- Do not expose the keyboard to liquids or excessive moisture.
- Avoid extreme temperatures. Operate and store the keyboard in a dry environment within typical room temperatures.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or modify the keyboard. This may void the warranty and could result in damage.
- Keep the keyboard away from strong magnetic fields.
- Clean the keyboard with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

## SETUP

### 1. Connect the Keyboard:

Locate an available PS/2 port on your computer. Insert the keyboard's PS/2 connector firmly into the port. Ensure the computer is powered off before connecting the keyboard for PS/2 connections.

### 2. Attach the Palm Rest (Optional):

Align the detachable palm rest with the front edge of the keyboard. Gently push the palm rest until it clicks securely into place. This provides ergonomic support for your wrists during extended use.

### 3. Power On Your Computer:

Once the keyboard is connected, power on your computer. The operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers for the keyboard.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. LED Backlight Control

The Azio Levatron L70 features a blue LED backlight to illuminate the keys. This backlight can be toggled on or off.

- To turn the backlight **ON** or **OFF**, locate the dedicated backlight switch key, typically found near the top right of the keyboard. Press this key to toggle the illumination.

### 2. Volume Adjustment Knob

A large, tactile volume knob is integrated into the top right corner of the keyboard for convenient audio control.

- Rotate the knob **clockwise** to increase the system volume.
- Rotate the knob **counter-clockwise** to decrease the system volume.
- Press the knob **down** to mute or unmute the audio.

### 3. Multi-Key Rollover

The keyboard supports Multi-Key Rollover, which ensures that multiple simultaneous key presses are registered accurately. This feature is particularly beneficial for gaming, where complex key combinations are often required.

- This feature operates automatically and does not require manual activation.

### 4. Windows Start Key Lock/Unlock

To prevent accidental interruptions during gaming, the Windows Start key can be locked.

- Locate the **Windows Lock Key** (often indicated by a Windows icon with a lock symbol).
- Press this key to toggle the Windows Start key functionality **ON** or **OFF**. When locked, pressing the Windows key will not open the Start menu.

### 5. Detachable Palm Rest

The included palm rest can be attached or detached based on user preference for comfort and ergonomics.

- To **attach**, align the clips on the palm rest with the slots on the front of the keyboard and press firmly until it clicks into place.
- To **detach**, gently pull the palm rest away from the keyboard while applying slight upward pressure to release the clips.

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:**

Regularly clean the keyboard to prevent dust and debris buildup. Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with

water or a mild cleaning solution. Avoid spraying liquids directly onto the keyboard. For stubborn dirt between keys, use compressed air.

- **Storage:**

When not in use for extended periods, store the keyboard in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

| Problem                          | Possible Cause                                       | Solution                                                                                                                                            |
|----------------------------------|------------------------------------------------------|-----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Keyboard not responding.         | Loose PS/2 connection; incorrect port; driver issue. | Ensure the PS/2 connector is fully inserted. Try a different PS/2 port if available. Restart your computer. Check Device Manager for driver status. |
| Backlight not turning on.        | Backlight feature is off.                            | Press the dedicated backlight toggle key to activate the illumination.                                                                              |
| Volume knob not adjusting audio. | System audio issue; software conflict.               | Check your computer's audio settings. Ensure no other audio software is interfering. Restart your computer.                                         |
| Windows key not working.         | Windows Lock feature is active.                      | Press the Windows Lock key to deactivate the lock feature.                                                                                          |
