INTRODUCTION

The CYBEX u.GO Baby Carrier is designed to provide a comfortable and secure way to carry your baby, promoting closeness and convenience. This sling combines natural materials with flexible design to offer multiple carrying positions, adapting to your child's growth and your comfort needs. Its elastic fabric, made from 100% natural cotton, simplifies the tying process and ensures optimal comfort for the child.

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use, setup, operation, and maintenance of your CYBEX u.GO Baby Carrier.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize your child's safety when using the baby carrier. Read and understand all instructions before use. Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury.

- Ensure your baby's airway is always clear and unobstructed. Regularly check on your baby, especially newborns, to ensure they are breathing freely.
- Maintain a snug fit. The carrier should be tight enough to hold your baby securely against your body, preventing slumping.
- Support your baby's head and neck, especially for infants who cannot hold their heads up independently.
- Always check all knots and wraps are secure before and during use.
- Be mindful of your surroundings. Avoid activities that could pose a risk to your baby while carrying them, such as cooking, running, or operating machinery.
- The carrier is suitable for babies up to 18 kilograms. Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation.
- Discontinue use if the carrier shows any signs of wear, tear, or damage.

SETUP

The CYBEX u.GO is a baby sling designed for individual tying. Proper setup ensures both comfort and safety for your child.

Initial Inspection

Upon unpacking, inspect the carrier for any manufacturing defects, loose threads, or damage. Ensure all fabric is intact and free from tears or holes.

Preparing the Sling

The u.GO sling is a long piece of fabric. Before tying, ensure the fabric is untangled and laid out smoothly. The elastic nature of the 100% natural cotton fabric makes it adaptable for various tying methods.

1. Unfold the entire length of the sling.
2. Identify the center of the sling, often marked with a small label or a distinct pattern. This center point will typically be placed on your body or your baby's back, depending on the carrying position.
3. Practice tying without your baby first to become familiar with the wrapping techniques and ensure a secure fit.

OPERATING

The CYBEX u.GO Baby Carrier offers multiple carrying positions to suit your baby's age and developmental stage, as well as your comfort. The key to safe and comfortable carrying is achieving a snug and supportive fit, ensuring the baby is in a "spread-squat" or "M" position, with knees higher than the bottom.

Front Carry - Inward Facing (Newborn to Infant)

This position is ideal for newborns and younger infants, providing excellent head and neck support and promoting bonding.

1. Place the center of the sling across your chest.
2. Cross the ends behind your back and bring them over your shoulders, creating two shoulder passes.
3. Bring the ends under your baby's legs and tie a secure knot behind your back or at your side.
4. Ensure the fabric spreads evenly across your baby's back and from knee to knee, supporting their natural "M" position.

Front Carry - Outward Facing (Older Infants)

For older infants with good head and neck control who are curious about their surroundings.

1. Begin with a similar wrap as the inward-facing carry, but position your baby facing outwards.
2. Ensure the fabric supports your baby from knee to knee and their back is well-supported.
3. Monitor your baby for overstimulation and turn them inward if they become fussy or tired.

Back Carry (Toddlers)

Suitable for older babies and toddlers with strong trunk control. Requires practice to master safely.

1. Position the center of the sling on your back.
2. Carefully place your baby on your back, ensuring they are centered and secure.
3. Bring the fabric ends over your shoulders and cross them in front, then bring them back around to tie securely.
4. Always use a spotter when first attempting a back carry.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life of your CYBEX u.GO Baby Carrier and ensure it remains hygienic and safe for your baby.

Cleaning Instructions

- The fabric covers are machine washable.
- Wash at a maximum temperature of 30°C (86°F).
- Use a mild detergent.
- Do not bleach.
- Tumble dry on low heat or air dry. Air drying is recommended to preserve fabric integrity.
- Do not iron.
- Do not dry clean.

Storage

Store the carrier in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use. Ensure it is completely dry before storing to prevent mold or mildew.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your CYBEX u.GO Baby Carrier, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Carrier feels too loose or baby is slumping.	Insufficiently tight wrap; incorrect tying method.	Re-tie the carrier, ensuring the fabric is snug against both your and your baby's body. Watch instructional videos for proper wrapping techniques.
Baby's legs are dangling straight down.	Lack of knee-to-knee support; fabric not spread wide enough.	Adjust the fabric to ensure it spreads from one knee to the other, supporting the baby in an "M" position (knees higher than bottom).
Discomfort for the wearer (shoulder or back pain).	Uneven weight distribution; incorrect posture; carrier not snug enough.	Ensure the fabric is spread evenly over your shoulders and back. Tighten the wrap to bring the baby closer to your center of gravity. Adjust your posture.
Fabric appears worn or damaged after washing.	Incorrect washing temperature or harsh detergents.	Always follow care instructions: machine wash at 30°C, use mild detergent, and air dry. Discontinue use if fabric integrity is compromised.
