1. Introduction

The Weber Q 2200 Gas Grill is a versatile and compact liquid propane grill designed for both home use and portability. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your grill.

3. PRODUCT FEATURES

The Weber Q 2200 Gas Grill is equipped with several features designed for convenience and optimal grilling performance:

- Total Cooking Area: 280 square inches, providing ample space for various foods.
- Stainless Steel Burner: Ensures durability and long-lasting performance with a 12,000 BTU-per-hour input.
- **Porcelain-Enameled, Cast-Iron Cooking Grates:** Designed for even heat distribution and excellent searing. These split grates allow for a grate/griddle cooking combination (griddle sold separately).
- Electronic Ignition: For effortless and reliable startup.
- Lid Thermometer: Built into the tall lid, allowing you to monitor internal grill temperatures without lifting the lid.
- Fold-Down Side Tables: Two sturdy work tables provide extra space for preparation and serving, and fold down for compact storage.
- Removable Catch Pan: Located beneath the grill for easy cleanup of grease and drippings.
- Cast-Aluminum Lid and Body: Lightweight yet rugged construction.
- Fuel Type: Operates on disposable 14.1 or 16.4 oz. LP cylinders (sold separately). An optional LP adapter hose for 20-lb. tanks is available.

4. SETUP

Your Weber Q 2200 Gas Grill requires minimal assembly. Follow these general steps for initial setup:

- 1. Unpack Components: Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and ensure all components are present.
- 2. Assemble Grill: Attach the handle and thermometer to the lid. Place the cooking grates inside the grill body.
- 3. **Install LP Cylinder:** Connect a 14.1 or 16.4 oz. disposable LP cylinder to the grill's regulator. Ensure a secure, leak-free connection. If using a 20-lb. tank, connect the optional adapter hose.
- 4. **Position Grill:** Place the grill on a stable, level, non-combustible surface away from flammable materials. Ensure adequate ventilation.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to operate your Weber Q 2200 Gas Grill:

- 1. **Prepare for Ignition:** Ensure the lid is open. Turn the burner control knob to the "START/HIGH" position.
- 2. **Ignite Grill:** Press the electronic ignition button. You should hear a clicking sound and see the burner ignite. If the burner does not ignite within 5 seconds, turn the control knob to "OFF", wait 5 minutes for gas to clear, and repeat the process.
- 3. **Preheat:** Close the lid and allow the grill to preheat for 10-15 minutes, or until the lid thermometer reaches your desired cooking temperature.
- 4. **Cooking:** Place food on the cooking grates. Adjust the control knob to regulate the heat as needed. The tall lid allows for grilling larger items like small roasts and birds.
- 5. Monitoring Temperature: Use the built-in lid thermometer to monitor the internal temperature of the grill.
- 6. After Cooking: Turn the burner control knob to "OFF" and disconnect the LP cylinder if storing the grill.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your grill:

- Clean Cooking Grates: After each use, brush the grates clean while they are still warm.
- **Empty Catch Pan:** The removable catch pan should be emptied and cleaned regularly to prevent grease buildup and potential flare-ups.
- Clean Exterior: Wipe down the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Inspect Components: Periodically check the burner, gas hose, and connections for any signs of wear, damage, or

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Weber Q 2200 Gas Grill, consider the following common troubleshooting tips:

• Grill Not Lighting:

- Check if the LP cylinder is properly connected and has gas.
- Ensure the electronic ignition button is being pressed firmly.
- Verify that the burner control knob is in the "START/HIGH" position.

• Low Heat Output:

- Confirm the LP cylinder is not low on gas.
- Check for any obstructions in the burner tubes.
- Ensure the regulator is not in bypass mode (reset by turning off grill, disconnecting LP, waiting, then reconnecting and slowly opening gas).

• Flare-ups:

- Clean the cooking grates and catch pan to remove excess grease.
- Trim excess fat from meats before grilling.
