# Weber Q2000 Liquid Propane Grill Instruction Manual

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Weber Q2000 Liquid Propane Grill, a restyled version of the Weber Q 200, offers robust performance and sleek design. It features enhanced functional and aesthetic elements, including a larger grip handle, ergonomic side handles, sturdy cradles, and spacious fold-out side tables. Designed for versatility, its split grates allow for combined grilling and griddle cooking (griddle sold separately). This grill is suitable for camping, tailgating, or as a stationary grill in outdoor living spaces. Constructed with a seamless stainless steel burner, cast-aluminum lid, and body, it ensures durability and consistent performance. It operates with disposable 14.1 or 16.4 oz. LP cylinders (sold separately).

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

The Weber Q2000 grill comes fully assembled out of the box, simplifying the initial setup process. Follow these steps to prepare your grill for first use:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the grill and all components from the packaging. Ensure all protective materials are removed.
2. **Side Table Deployment:** Extend the fold-out side tables for additional workspace. These tables provide greater rigidity

and convenience during grilling.

3. **Propane Cylinder Connection:** Connect a disposable 14.1 or 16.4 oz. LP cylinder (sold separately) to the designated connection point on the grill. Ensure a secure, leak-free connection.
4. **Drip Pan Installation:** Place the removable catch pan beneath the grill body to collect drippings for easy cleanup.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your Weber Q2000 grill is straightforward, designed for reliable performance.

1. **Pre-heating:** Open the grill lid. Turn the infinite control burner valve to the high setting. Press the push-button ignition to light the burner. Allow the grill to pre-heat for approximately 10-15 minutes with the lid closed to reach desired cooking temperature.
2. **Temperature Control:** Adjust the infinite control burner valve to regulate the heat. The cast-aluminum lid and body are designed to retain heat efficiently, ensuring even cooking.
3. **Cooking:** Place food on the porcelain-enameled cast-iron cooking grates. The split grates allow for versatile cooking options.
4. **Post-Cooking:** After cooking, turn off the burner valve and disconnect the propane cylinder when the grill is cool.

## MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Weber Q2000 grill.

- **Grates Cleaning:** After each use, once the grates have cooled, clean them with a grill brush to remove food residue. The porcelain-enameled cast-iron grates are designed for easy cleaning.
- **Drip Pan Emptying:** Regularly check and empty the removable catch pan to prevent grease buildup and potential flare-ups.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe down the exterior surfaces of the grill, including the lid and side tables, with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Burner Inspection:** Periodically inspect the stainless steel burner for any blockages or damage. Ensure the burner ports are clear for even flame distribution.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Weber Q2000 grill, refer to these common troubleshooting tips:

- **Grill Not Lighting:** Ensure the propane cylinder is properly connected and has gas. Check that the burner valve is open. If the ignition button does not spark, check the igniter electrode and wire connection.
- **Low Flame/Uneven Heat:** Verify that the propane cylinder is not low or empty. Check for any kinks in the gas hose.

- Ensure the burner ports are clear of debris.
- **Flare-ups:** Excessive flare-ups can be caused by grease buildup. Ensure the drip pan is clean and the cooking grates are free of heavy residue. Trim excess fat from meats before grilling.
