1. Introduction




Figure 1: Overview of the Dodge Genuine Tubular Side Steps. These steps feature a black finish and integrated stepping pads.

3. COMPATIBILITY

These tubular side steps are specifically designed for the following vehicle models:

• 2011-2013 Dodge Durango

Ensure your vehicle matches the specified model years before proceeding with installation.

4. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety during installation and use. Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in injury or damage to your vehicle.

- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), such as safety glasses and gloves.
- Ensure the vehicle is parked on a level surface with the parking brake engaged.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of the side steps (consult vehicle manufacturer specifications if available).
- Periodically inspect the side steps and mounting hardware for looseness or damage.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

5.2. Installation Steps

- 2. **Identify Mounting Points:** Locate the factory mounting points along the rocker panel or frame of your Dodge Durango. These are typically pre-drilled holes or existing bolt locations.
- 3. **Attach Brackets:** Secure the mounting brackets (if separate from the steps) to the vehicle's frame using the provided hardware. Hand-tighten bolts initially.
- 4. **Position Side Step:** Carefully lift and position the tubular side step onto the attached brackets. Ensure proper alignment.
- 5. Secure Side Step: Attach the side step to the brackets using the remaining hardware. Hand-tighten all bolts.
- 6. **Adjust and Torque:** Adjust the side step for optimal positioning and levelness. Once satisfied, progressively tighten all mounting bolts to the vehicle manufacturer's recommended torque specifications. *Do not overtighten.*
- 7. **Repeat for Other Side:** Follow the same procedure for installing the side step on the opposite side of the vehicle
- 8. **Final Inspection:** Double-check all bolts for tightness and ensure the side steps are securely mounted and stable.

6. OPERATING (USAGE)

The tubular side steps are designed for easy and safe vehicle entry and exit. Step onto the textured pads for secure footing. Ensure your footwear is clean and dry to prevent slipping.

- · Always step onto the designated textured areas.
- Avoid placing excessive weight on the steps, especially when entering or exiting.
- Do not use the side steps as a jacking point or for vehicle recovery.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and functionality of your side steps.

- Cleaning: Wash the side steps regularly with mild automotive soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all mounting hardware for tightness. Re-torque bolts if necessary. Check for any signs of corrosion, cracks, or damage to the steps or mounting brackets.
- Winter Care: In areas with road salt or de-icing chemicals, rinse the steps frequently to prevent corrosion.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem Possible Cause	Solution
------------------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Side step feels loose	Mounting bolts are loose.	Inspect and re-torque all mounting bolts to specifications.
Unusual noise from step	Loose hardware or contact with vehicle body.	Check all mounting points. Ensure no part of the step is rubbing against the vehicle.
Difficulty aligning step	Incorrect bracket placement or vehicle not level.	Verify bracket orientation and mounting points. Ensure vehicle is on a level surface.
