4. MAINTENANCE AND DISPOSAL

- **Skin Irritation:** If skin irritation develops, ensure the product is changed frequently. Clean and dry the skin thoroughly between changes. If irritation persists, discontinue use and consult a healthcare professional.
- **Discomfort:** If the underwear feels uncomfortable, re-check the sizing. Ensure it is pulled up fully and evenly. The material is designed to be soft against the skin, but an incorrect fit can cause chafing or pressure.
