5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Garnish is loose:** Ensure all clips are fully engaged. Gently press along the length of the garnish to re-seat it. If clips are broken, replacement may be necessary.
- Gaps or improper fit: Double-check that the garnish is correctly aligned with the vehicle's body. Remove and re-install, ensuring proper alignment before pressing clips into place. Verify that the part number matches your vehicle's requirements.
- Damage to garnish: If the garnish is cracked, bent, or otherwise damaged, it should be replaced to maintain vehicle aesthetics and functionality.
