# Whirlpool W10510627RB Aqua Lift Oven Cleaning Kit User Manual

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Whirlpool W10510627RB Aqua Lift Oven Cleaning Kit is designed to assist in the efficient cleaning of ovens equipped with AquaLift self-clean technology. This kit provides essential tools to address common oven soils after an AquaLift cycle.

### Key Features:

- Contains one expanding sponge, one scrubbing sponge, and one scraper.
- Designed to work with the AquaLift self-clean cycle, which uses heat and water to loosen baked-on spills.
- Aids in removing loosened soils without harsh chemical odors.
- Compatible with both electric and gas ovens featuring AquaLift technology.

## 2. KIT COMPONENTS

---

The Aqua Lift Oven Cleaning Kit includes the following items:

1. **Expanding Sponge:** Designed to absorb residual water from the oven cavity.
2. **Scrubbing Sponge:** A double-sided sponge with a smooth side for wiping spills and a rough side for more stubborn stains.
3. **Scraper:** Used for removing extensively burned-on soil after the AquaLift cycle.

### 3. USAGE INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps to effectively clean your AquaLift-equipped oven using the cleaning kit:

1. **Prepare the Oven:** Ensure your oven is cool before starting. Remove all oven racks and accessories.
2. **Run AquaLift Cycle:** Follow your oven's specific instructions to run the AquaLift self-clean cycle. This cycle uses water and low heat to loosen baked-on soils.
3. **Prompt Cleaning:** For best results, begin cleaning immediately after the AquaLift cycle completes and the oven has cooled sufficiently to be safe to touch. Do not wait for the oven to fully cool down for an extended period, as this may make soil removal more difficult.
4. **Remove Loose Debris:** Use the smooth side of the scrubbing sponge to wipe away any loose spills and residual water from the oven cavity.
5. **Address Stubborn Stains:** For more stubborn stains, use the rough side of the scrubbing sponge. Apply gentle pressure and scrub the affected areas.
6. **Scrape Burned-On Soil:** For extensively burned-on soil that remains after scrubbing, use the scraper. Carefully position the scraper at an angle and gently push to lift the hardened soil. Avoid excessive force to

prevent scratching the oven surface.

7. **Absorb Residual Water:** After cleaning, use the expanding sponge to soak up any remaining water in the bottom of the oven cavity.
8. **Final Wipe:** Wipe the oven interior with a clean, damp cloth to remove any last residues.

## 4. MAINTENANCE TIPS

---

- Clean the sponges and scraper with warm, soapy water after each use. Rinse thoroughly and allow them to air dry completely before storing.
- Store the kit components in a dry place to prevent mildew or damage.
- Replace sponges when they show signs of wear, such as tearing or loss of abrasive texture.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### Difficulty Removing Soil After AquaLift Cycle:

- **Issue:** Baked-on soil remains difficult to remove even after running the AquaLift cycle.
- **Solution:** Ensure you are cleaning the oven promptly after the AquaLift cycle completes and the oven has cooled enough to be handled safely. Waiting too long can allow the loosened soil to re-harden, making it more challenging to remove. Re-run the AquaLift cycle if necessary and clean immediately afterward.
- **Solution:** For very stubborn spots, ensure you are using the rough side of the scrubbing sponge and the scraper as directed. Multiple applications of the AquaLift cycle and subsequent cleaning may be required for heavily soiled ovens.
