INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of the Peerless-AV PPF Pro Series Projector Flush Mount. Designed for multimedia projectors, this mount offers robust support and flexible adjustments to optimize your projection setup.

The PPF mount is engineered to hold projectors weighing up to 50 lbs and features extensive adjustability including tilt, roll, and swivel, ensuring precise alignment for various viewing environments. It includes a universal Spider® adapter plate for compatibility with most projector models and is UL listed for safety.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before beginning installation, ensure you have all necessary tools and that the mounting surface is structurally sound and capable of supporting the combined weight of the mount and projector.

Tools Required:

- Drill
- Drill bits appropriate for mounting surface
- Stud finder (for ceiling installation)
- Level
- Measuring tape
- Pencil

- Screwdriver set
- Safety glasses

Installation Steps:

1. **Identify Mounting Location:** Select a suitable location on the ceiling that provides optimal projection and is free from obstructions. Use a stud finder to locate ceiling joists or other structural supports if mounting to drywall.
2. **Attach Ceiling Plate:** Secure the mount's ceiling plate to the chosen location using appropriate fasteners (not included, as fastener type depends on ceiling material). Ensure the plate is level before tightening.
3. **Assemble Projector Adapter Plate:** Attach the universal Spider® adapter plate to your projector using the screws provided with the mount, aligning with your projector's mounting points.
4. **Mount Projector to Ceiling Plate:** Carefully lift the projector (with adapter plate attached) and connect it to the ceiling plate. Follow the specific locking mechanism instructions provided with the mount to ensure a secure connection.
5. **Initial Adjustments:** Once securely mounted, make initial adjustments to the projector's position.

OPERATING AND ADJUSTMENTS

The PPF mount allows for fine-tuning of your projector's image. Adjustments should be made carefully to avoid damage to the projector or mount.

Adjustment Features:

- **Tilt (-5° to -30°):** Adjust the vertical angle of the projector to raise or lower the image on the screen. Loosen the tilt adjustment screws, set the desired angle, and re-tighten.
- **Roll (±20°):** Correct any horizontal tilt or rotation of the image. Loosen the roll adjustment screws, rotate the projector to level the image, and re-tighten.
- **Swivel (±20°):** Rotate the projector horizontally to align the image with the screen. Loosen the swivel mechanism, turn the projector to the desired direction, and re-tighten.

Note: Always support the projector when making adjustments to prevent accidental drops.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your projector mount.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the mount. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the finish.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically inspect all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Over time, vibrations can cause fasteners to loosen.
- **Structural Integrity:** Annually inspect the mounting surface and the mount itself for any signs of wear, damage, or instability. Address any issues immediately.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your projector mount.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Projector image is crooked or not level.	Roll adjustment is off.	Adjust the roll feature of the mount until the image is level. Refer to the "Operating and Adjustments" section.
Projector image is too high or too low.	Tilt adjustment is off.	Adjust the tilt feature of the mount to raise or lower the image. Refer to the "Operating and Adjustments" section.
Mount feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose fasteners or inadequate mounting surface.	Check all mounting screws and bolts for tightness. Ensure the ceiling structure is robust enough to support the weight. If unsure, consult a professional.
Projector cannot be attached to the mount.	Incorrect adapter plate assembly or projector incompatibility.	Ensure the universal Spider® adapter plate is correctly attached to your projector. Verify your projector's mounting points are compatible with the adapter plate.


