# Coleman RoadTrip LXE Portable Propane Grill User Manual

Model: 2000017442

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Coleman RoadTrip LXE Portable Propane Grill is designed for convenient outdoor cooking, perfect for camping, picnics, and tailgating. This grill features a collapsible design, individually adjustable dual burners, and an Instastart ignition system. Its Swaptop interchangeable design allows for versatile cooking options, and the PerfectFlow technology ensures consistent heat output. The grill also includes sliding side tables for convenience and a removable grease tray for easy cleaning.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

**WARNING:** For outdoor use only. Improper installation, adjustment, alteration, service, or maintenance can cause injury or property damage. Read the installation, operating, and maintenance instructions thoroughly before installing or servicing this equipment.

- Always operate the grill on a level, stable surface.
- Keep children and pets away from the grill during operation.
- Do not store or use gasoline or other flammable vapors and liquids in the vicinity of this or any other appliance.
- Ensure adequate ventilation. Never operate the grill in an enclosed space.
- Check for gas leaks before each use.
- Always turn off the gas supply at the propane cylinder after use.
- Allow the grill to cool completely before moving or cleaning.

## 3. COMPONENTS OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your Coleman RoadTrip LXE grill:

- **Grill Grates:** Porcelain-coated cast iron cooking surfaces.
- **Dual Burners:** Individually adjustable for precise temperature control.
- **Instastart Ignition:** Push-button ignition for quick and easy startup.
- **Control Knobs:** Adjust flame intensity for each burner.
- **Side Tables:** Sliding tables for food preparation and utensil holding.
- **Drip Pan:** Removable tray for collecting grease and drippings.
- **Propane Regulator:** Connects to a 16.4 oz propane cylinder (sold separately).
- **Collapsible Stand with Wheels:** For easy transport and storage.

## 4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack and Assemble:** Remove all packaging materials. Unfold the collapsible stand and ensure it is locked securely in place. Extend the sliding side tables.
2. **Install Grill Grates:** Place the porcelain-coated cast iron grill grates onto the cooking surface. Ensure they are seated properly over the burners.
3. **Connect Propane Cylinder:**

- Ensure all burner control knobs are in the "OFF" position.
  - Screw a 16.4 oz propane cylinder (not included) onto the regulator until hand-tight. Do not overtighten.
  - Check for any gas leaks by applying a soapy water solution to the connection points. Bubbles indicate a leak; tighten the connection or replace the cylinder if necessary.
4. **Prepare Drip Pan:** Fill the drip pan with a small amount of water to help catch grease and prevent flare-ups.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 1. Ignition:

- Open the grill lid.
- Turn one burner control knob to the "HIGH" position.
- Press the Instastart ignition button repeatedly until the burner ignites. You should hear a clicking sound and see a flame.
- If the burner does not ignite within 5 seconds, turn the knob to "OFF", wait 5 minutes, and repeat the process.
- Once one burner is lit, you can light the other burner by turning its control knob to "HIGH".

2. **Temperature Control:** Adjust the individual burner control knobs to achieve your desired cooking temperature. The dual burners allow for different heat zones.

3. **Cooking:** Place food on the grill grates. Close the lid for faster cooking and even heat distribution.

4. **Swaptop Cooktops:** The grill is compatible with Coleman Swaptop accessories (sold separately), such as griddle tops or stove grates, which can be interchanged with the standard grill grates for varied cooking.

5. **Shutting Down:** When finished cooking, turn all burner control knobs to the "OFF" position. Disconnect the propane cylinder once the grill has cooled.

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your grill.

- **Grill Grates:** After each use, allow the grates to cool slightly. Scrape off any food residue with a grill brush. For a deeper clean, remove the grates and wash them with warm, soapy water.
- **Drip Pan:** The removable drip pan should be emptied and cleaned after each use to prevent grease buildup. Dispose of grease responsibly.
- **Exterior:** Wipe down the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Burners:** Periodically check burner ports for blockages (e.g., from insects or food debris). Use a wire brush or paperclip to clear any obstructions.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your grill, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Burner Fails to Ignite:**

- Check if the propane cylinder is properly connected and has gas.

- Ensure the burner control knob is turned to "HIGH".
  - Verify the Instastart ignition button is clicking and producing a spark. If not, check the igniter electrode for damage or blockages.
- **Low Flame or Uneven Heat:**
    - Check the propane cylinder for low fuel.
    - Ensure the propane regulator is fully tightened and not obstructed.
    - Clean burner ports if they appear clogged.
- **Grease Fires:**
    - Ensure the drip pan is clean and contains water.
    - Trim excess fat from meats before grilling.
    - If a grease fire occurs, turn off all burners and the gas supply. Keep the lid open and allow the fire to burn out. Do not use water to extinguish a grease fire.
