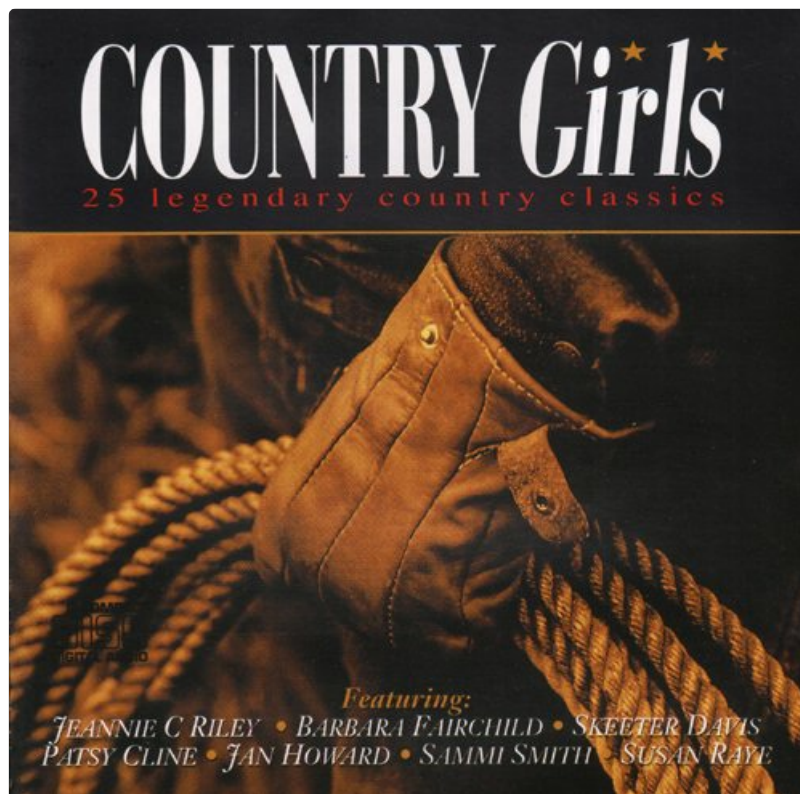

INTRODUCTION

SETUP

To begin enjoying your "Country Girls" Audio CD, follow these simple steps:

1. **Unpack the CD:** Carefully remove the Audio CD from its jewel case. Hold the disc by its edges to avoid touching the playing surface.
2. **Choose a Compatible Player:** Insert the CD into any standard audio CD player, computer CD/DVD drive, or compatible car stereo system. Ensure the label side of the CD is facing upwards (or as indicated by your player).
3. **Power On:** Turn on your audio player. The player should automatically detect the CD and begin playback, or display a menu for track selection.

OPERATING

Basic controls for playing your Audio CD:

- **Play/Pause:** Press the **Play** button to start playback. Press the **Pause** button to temporarily stop playback, and press it again to resume.
- **Stop:** Press the **Stop** button to end playback and reset the disc to the beginning.
- **Skip Track:** Use the **Next Track** (>>|) or **Previous Track** (|<<) buttons to navigate between songs.
- **Fast Forward/Rewind:** Hold down the **Fast Forward** (>>>) or **Rewind** (<<<) buttons to quickly move through a track.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the volume using your audio player's dedicated volume controls.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Audio CD:

- **Handling:** Always hold the CD by its outer edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playing surface to prevent fingerprints and scratches.
- **Cleaning:** If the disc becomes dirty or smudged, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth (e.g., microfiber). Wipe from the center of the disc outwards in straight lines, not in a circular motion. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity, which can warp the disc or damage the data layer.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Be careful not to drop the disc or slide it across rough surfaces. Deep scratches can cause playback errors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing your CD, try the following solutions:

- **Disc Not Playing/Recognized:**
 - Ensure the CD is inserted correctly into the player, label side up.
 - Check if the player is powered on and functioning correctly with other CDs.
 - Gently clean the disc as described in the Maintenance section.
- **Skipping or Stuttering Playback:**
 - Inspect the playing surface for dirt, smudges, or scratches. Clean the disc if necessary.
 - If scratches are present, they may be causing the issue. Minor scratches can sometimes be buffed out with

specialized CD repair kits, but deep scratches may render the disc unplayable.

- Ensure the CD player is on a stable surface to prevent vibrations from causing skips.

• **No Sound:**

- Check the volume level on your player and connected audio system.
- Ensure all audio cables are securely connected.
- Verify that the correct input source is selected on your audio receiver/amplifier.
