Schacht Mighty Wolf Trap (FL3832) Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the assembly, installation, and proper use of the Schacht Mighty Wolf Trap (FL3832). This accessory is designed to enhance your weaving experience by providing a convenient storage solution for your tools directly on your Schacht Wolf series loom.

The Mighty Wolf Trap serves as a practical tray for holding shuttles, bobbins, and other small weaving implements, keeping them within easy reach during operation.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Schacht Mighty Wolf Trap is designed for straightforward attachment to your Schacht Wolf series loom. Ensure your loom is stable and assembled according to its own instruction manual before proceeding.

Components:

- Mighty Wolf Trap assembly (wooden tray)
- Mounting hardware (typically bolts and wing nuts, or similar fasteners)

Installation Steps:

1. **Identify Mounting Points:** Locate the pre-drilled holes or designated attachment points on the side frame of your Schacht Wolf loom. These are typically positioned to allow the trap to sit horizontally and securely.
2. **Position the Trap:** Align the mounting holes on the Mighty Wolf Trap with the corresponding holes on your loom's side frame. Ensure the tray is oriented correctly, with the open side facing upwards to hold tools.
3. **Secure with Hardware:** Insert the provided bolts through the aligned holes from the outside of the loom frame, then through the trap. Secure them with the wing nuts or other fasteners on the inside.

Hand-tighten the fasteners initially.

4. **Check Stability:** Gently test the trap for stability. If it wobbles, tighten the fasteners further until the trap is firmly attached to the loom. Avoid over-tightening, which could damage the wood.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Mighty Wolf Trap is a passive accessory designed for convenience during weaving. Its operation is straightforward:

- **Tool Storage:** Place your shuttles, bobbins, yarn, scissors, or other small weaving tools directly into the tray. The raised edges prevent items from rolling off.
- **Accessibility:** Position the trap on your loom where it is most comfortable and accessible for you while weaving.
- **Capacity:** While durable, avoid overloading the trap with excessively heavy items to maintain stability and prevent strain on the mounting points.

The primary function is to keep essential tools organized and within arm's reach, improving efficiency and reducing interruptions during your weaving projects.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity of your Schacht Mighty Wolf Trap.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wooden surfaces with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and debris. For stubborn

marks, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed immediately by a dry cloth. Avoid harsh chemical cleaners, which can damage the wood finish.

- **Wood Care:** Periodically, you may wish to apply a wood conditioner or wax suitable for natural wood products to maintain its appearance and protect the finish. Follow the instructions of the wood care product.
- **Hardware Check:** Regularly inspect the mounting hardware (bolts, nuts) to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary to prevent wobbling or detachment.
- **Storage:** If removing the trap for storage, keep it in a dry environment away from extreme temperature fluctuations to prevent warping or cracking of the wood.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues with the Mighty Wolf Trap are related to installation or general wear.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Trap is wobbly or loose.	Mounting hardware is not sufficiently tightened.	Check and tighten all bolts and nuts securing the trap to the loom frame.
Tools roll out of the trap.	Trap is not level or is overloaded.	Ensure the trap is installed horizontally. Reduce the number or weight of items stored if overloading is suspected.
Wood appears dry or dull.	Lack of regular wood conditioning.	Apply a suitable wood conditioner or wax as part of routine maintenance.
