# Lion Locks 1500 Key Storage Lockbox Instruction Manual

## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

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The Lion Locks 1500 Key Storage Lockbox is a durable and secure solution for storing keys. Designed for convenience and protection, this portable key holder features a customizable 4-digit combination lock, making it ideal for various applications from real estate showings to emergency home access. Its robust metal construction ensures resistance against rust and tampering, providing a reliable way to share access to keys without compromising security.

## 2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

### 2.1 Setting Your Combination

1. **Open the Lockbox:** The lockbox is factory preset to '0-0-0-0'. Align these numbers with the indicator line and pull down the shackle to open the key compartment.
2. **Locate the Reset Lever:** Inside the key compartment, on the back of the front panel, you will find a small metal lever.
3. **Set to Reset Position:** Push the lever from position 'A' to 'B' (or from 'UP' to 'DOWN', depending on the specific model marking).
4. **Choose Your New Combination:** Rotate the dials to your desired 4-digit combination. Ensure these numbers are aligned with the indicator line.
5. **Return Reset Lever:** Push the lever back to position 'A' (or 'UP'). Your new combination is now set.
6. **Test the Combination:** Scramble the dials and then enter your new combination to ensure it opens correctly.

**Important:** Remember your combination. There is no master key or override to open the lockbox if the combination is forgotten.

## 2.2 Mounting the Lockbox

The Lion Locks 1500 is designed for portable use and can be easily hung on most doorknobs or handles. Its compact design allows for discreet placement.

- Ensure the shackle is securely closed around the chosen fixture.
- Verify that the lockbox is stable and cannot be easily removed.

## 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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### 3.1 Opening the Lockbox

1. **Align Combination:** Rotate the dials to your set 4-digit combination, ensuring each number is perfectly aligned with the indicator line.
2. **Depress Release Button:** Push the release button located above the dials. The key compartment door will spring open.

### 3.2 Storing and Retrieving Keys

- Place up to 5 standard-sized keys inside the compartment. Note that larger items like car key fobs may not fit.
- To close, push the compartment door firmly until it clicks shut.
- **Scramble Dials:** After closing, always scramble the dials to a random set of numbers to secure the lockbox.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a silicone-based lubricant to the shackle and combination dials to ensure smooth operation, especially in outdoor environments.
- **Rust Prevention:** The lockbox is designed to be rust-proof. However, regular inspection for any signs of wear or damage is recommended to maintain its integrity.
- **Protective Padding:** The lockbox includes protective padding to prevent damage to door surfaces when hung. Ensure this padding remains intact.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

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- **Lockbox will not open:**
  - Ensure the correct 4-digit combination is entered and perfectly aligned with the indicator line.
  - Verify that the combination has not been accidentally changed. If unsure, try the factory default '0-0-0-0' or any previously set combinations.
  - Apply slight pressure to the shackle while entering the combination and pressing the release button.
- **Dials are stiff or hard to turn:**
  - Clean the dials and surrounding areas to remove any dirt or debris.
  - Apply a small amount of silicone-based lubricant to the moving parts of the dials.
- **Shackle is difficult to close:**
  - Ensure the key compartment door is fully closed and nothing is obstructing the shackle mechanism.
  - Check for any debris in the shackle holes.
