INTRODUCTION

The Monoprice PS/2 Keyboard/Mouse to USB Converter Adapter allows you to connect legacy PS/2 keyboards and mice to modern USB-equipped computer systems. This adapter is ideal for users who wish to continue using their specialized PS/2 input devices with computers lacking dedicated PS/2 ports. It is also suitable for KVM extender setups where PS/2 peripherals need to interface with USB KVMs. The adapter operates on a plug-and-play basis, requiring no additional software or drivers for installation.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to properly install and use your Monoprice PS/2 to USB Converter Adapter:

1. Ensure your computer is powered on and fully booted into its operating system (e.g., Windows, macOS, Linux).
2. **Do NOT connect your PS/2 keyboard or mouse to the adapter yet.**
3. Plug the USB-A connector of the Monoprice adapter into an available USB port on your computer.
4. Allow the operating system a few moments to detect and install the necessary generic drivers for the USB device. This process is typically automatic and may display a notification once complete.
5. Once the adapter is recognized by your system, connect your PS/2 keyboard to the purple PS/2 port on the adapter and your PS/2 mouse to the green PS/2 port on the adapter.
6. Your PS/2 keyboard and mouse should now be functional.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the Monoprice PS/2 to USB Converter Adapter is correctly set up, your connected PS/2 keyboard and mouse will function as standard USB input devices. No special operating procedures are required beyond the normal use of your keyboard and mouse.

- **Keyboard Functionality:** All standard keyboard functions, including alphanumeric keys, function keys, and numeric keypad, should operate normally.
- **Mouse Functionality:** Standard mouse functions such as cursor movement, left-click, right-click, and scroll wheel (if applicable) will be supported.
- **Hot-Plugging:** While the adapter is generally plug-and-play, it is recommended to connect the PS/2 devices to the adapter before plugging the adapter into the USB port for optimal detection.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your PS/2 devices after connecting them via the adapter, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Device Not Detected:**
 - Ensure the USB connector is fully inserted into a working USB port on your computer.
 - Verify that the PS/2 keyboard and mouse connectors are securely plugged into their respective color-coded ports on the adapter (purple for keyboard, green for mouse).
 - Try connecting the adapter to a different USB port on your computer.
 - Disconnect the adapter, restart your computer, and then follow the setup instructions again.
- **Intermittent Functionality / Random Keypresses:**
 - While rare, some users have reported intermittent issues like random or repeated keypresses. This can sometimes be resolved by ensuring a stable connection or trying a different USB port.
 - Ensure the PS/2 devices themselves are in good working condition. Test them with a native PS/2 port if available.
- **Specific Keys/Functions Not Working:**
 - Most standard functions are supported. However, advanced multimedia keys or custom functions on some PS/2 keyboards may not be fully recognized by the generic USB drivers. This is a limitation of the conversion process rather than a defect.

- **No Power to Devices:**

- Confirm that the USB port provides sufficient power. Try connecting to a directly connected USB port on the computer rather than a USB hub.
