IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic precautions should always be observed, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using this appliance.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water. This product is designed for shower-proof use, but not for full submersion.
- Keep the appliance away from water sources when not in use.
- Do not use if the appliance or charging cord is damaged.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- Only use attachments supplied by Remington.
- Ensure the charging adapter is kept dry.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Remington Bodyguard BHT 2000 A is a versatile body hair trimmer designed for efficient and comfortable grooming. It features advanced blade technology and multiple attachments for various trimming needs.

Key Features

- **Titanium Coated Blades:** Engineered for precise and efficient trimming.
- **Trimmer Attachment:** For reducing hair length to desired settings.
- **Wheel Control:** Adjusts the comb for 5 length settings (e.g., 1mm to 5mm).
- **Dual Foil Groomer Attachment:** Provides irritation-free hair removal for a smooth finish.
- **Washable/Shower Proof:** Suitable for wet or dry use and easy cleaning under running water.
- **Rechargeable:** Cordless operation for convenience.

GETTING STARTED (SETUP)

Charging the Appliance

1. Ensure the appliance is switched off.
2. Connect the charging adapter to the appliance and then plug it into a wall outlet.
3. Allow the appliance to charge for the recommended time (refer to specifications for initial charge time).
The charging indicator light will illuminate.
4. For optimal battery life, fully discharge the battery every six months and then recharge it for 14-16 hours.

Attaching and Removing Attachments

- To attach an attachment (trimmer or foil groomer), align it with the body of the trimmer and push it firmly until it clicks into place.
- To remove an attachment, press the release button (if present) or gently pull the attachment away from the body.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Trimming Hair Length

1. Attach the trimmer comb.

2. Adjust the desired hair length using the wheel control. The settings typically range from 1 to 5, corresponding to different hair lengths.
3. Switch on the appliance.
4. Hold the trimmer with the comb flat against the skin and move it against the direction of hair growth.
5. For best results, ensure the skin is clean and dry before trimming.

Using the Dual Foil Groomer

1. Attach the dual foil groomer head.
2. Switch on the appliance.
3. Gently press the foil head against the skin and move it in short, circular motions or against the direction of hair growth for a close, smooth finish.
4. This attachment is designed for irritation-free hair removal on the body.

Wet and Dry Use

The Remington Bodyguard BHT 2000 A is shower-proof, allowing for convenient use in the shower or with shaving gels/foams. Always ensure the charging port is securely closed when using in wet conditions.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Cleaning

1. Switch off the appliance and disconnect it from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. Remove the attachment head.
3. Rinse the attachment head and blades under running water to remove hair clippings.
4. Use the cleaning brush (if provided) to remove stubborn hair from the blades.
5. Allow all parts to air dry completely before reattaching or storing.

Lubrication

Regular lubrication of the blades ensures optimal performance and longevity. Apply a small drop of light machine oil (specifically designed for trimmers) to the blades after every few uses, or as needed. Switch on the trimmer for a few seconds to distribute the oil evenly.

Storage

Store the appliance in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and out of reach of children. Ensure the blades are protected to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|--------------------------------------|--|--|
| Trimmer does not turn on. | Battery is discharged. | Charge the appliance for the recommended time. |
| Poor trimming performance. | Blades are dull or clogged with hair. | Clean and lubricate the blades. Consider replacing the blade head if excessively dull. |
| Appliance stops during use. | Battery is low. | Recharge the appliance. |
| Irritation after using foil groomer. | Skin not prepared, or foil head is worn. | Ensure skin is clean and dry. Replace the foil head if it shows signs of wear. |
