Introduction

This instruction manual provides comprehensive guidance for the assembly, safe operation, and maintenance of your Camaflexi Panel Style Solid Wood Low Bunk Bed, Twin-Over-Twin. This bunk bed system is designed for flexibility, allowing it to be configured as two individual twin beds when needed. Constructed from natural solid wood, it adheres to non-toxic and sustainable sourcing standards.

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

Important Safety Information

- Always follow assembly instructions precisely to ensure structural integrity.
- Ensure all hardware is securely tightened before use and periodically check for tightness.
- The top bunk is not suitable for children under 6 years of age.
- Do not allow more than one person on the top bunk at any time.
- The total weight capacity for this bunk bed is 650 pounds.
- Use only mattresses that meet the recommended dimensions to prevent entrapment.
- This product meets or exceeds all ASTM and US Government safety standards for low bunk beds.

Package Contents

Before assembly, verify that all components are present. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact Camaflexi customer support immediately.

- Upper Twin Bed Frame Components
- Lower Twin Bed Frame Components
- Side Attached Ladder
- Guard Rails (interchangeable)
- Slat Roll Foundations (for both upper and lower beds)
- Hardware Pack (bolts, screws, nuts, etc.)
- Assembly Tools (typically Allen wrench, screwdriver - not always included, prepare your own)

Note: Mattresses are not included with this bunk bed.

Setup and Assembly Instructions

Assembly requires at least two adults. Clear a spacious area for assembly. Keep all hardware out of reach of small children.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out and compare them against the parts list (refer to the separate parts diagram, if provided, or the general list above).
2. **Assemble Lower Bed Frame:** Begin by assembling the headboard and footboard of the lower twin bed with the side rails. Ensure all connections are secure but do not fully tighten bolts until the frame is complete.
3. **Install Lower Slat Roll Foundation:** Place the slat roll foundation onto the lower bed frame. Secure it according to the instructions, ensuring the extra-sturdy center rail support system is correctly installed.

- 4. **Assemble Upper Bed Frame:** Repeat the process for the upper twin bed frame, assembling its headboard, footboard, and side rails.
- 5. **Install Upper Slat Roll Foundation:** Place the slat roll foundation onto the upper bed frame.
- 6. **Attach Guard Rails:** Secure the guard rails to the upper bed frame. These are interchangeable, allowing you to position them as needed for safety.
- 7. **Stack Bed Frames:** With assistance, carefully lift and place the upper bed frame onto the lower bed frame, aligning the connecting posts. Secure them together using the provided hardware.
- 8. **Attach Ladder:** Secure the side attached ladder to the bunk bed frame. Ensure the extra-wide, deeply grooved steps are facing correctly and the ladder is firmly attached.
- 9. **Final Tightening:** Once the entire structure is assembled, go back and fully tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.

For visual assistance, refer to the product images provided. If you encounter difficulties, consult the troubleshooting section or contact customer support.

Operating Instructions

This bunk bed is designed for safe and flexible use. Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Mattress Placement:** Use standard Twin size mattresses. Ensure the mattress on the upper bunk does not exceed the height of the guard rails for safety.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the provided ladder for accessing the upper bunk. Do not climb on the bed frame or guard rails.
- **Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the total weight capacity of 650 pounds for the entire bunk bed. The upper bunk has its own weight limit, typically lower than the total, and should be used by one person at a time.
- **Conversion to Two Beds:** To convert the bunk bed into two separate twin beds, carefully remove the upper bed from the lower bed. Ensure all connecting hardware is detached. The guard rails and ladder should be removed from the upper bed if it is to be used as a standalone bed.

Maintenance

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your Camaflexi bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wood surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth followed immediately by a dry cloth can be used. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Re-tighten as necessary to maintain stability and safety.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources, which can cause wood to dry out or warp. Maintain a stable room temperature and humidity.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
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Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable	Loose hardware connections.	Inspect and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure all components are correctly aligned.
Squeaking noises	Loose connections or friction between wood parts.	Tighten all hardware. If squeaking persists, disassemble and reassemble the affected section, ensuring proper alignment.
Ladder feels insecure	Ladder not properly attached or hardware is loose.	Ensure the ladder is correctly hooked and all securing bolts are fully tightened.
