Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Camaflexi Panel Style Solid Wood Bunk Bed with Trundle. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference. Ensure all components are present and undamaged before proceeding.

Safety Information

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** The total weight capacity for this bunk bed is 650 pounds. This includes the weight of the mattress and occupants.
- **Mattress Requirements:** Use only standard Twin size mattresses for both upper and lower bunks, and the trundle bed.
- **Guard Rails:** The top bunk is equipped with guard rails. Ensure these are always securely in place.
- **Ladder Safety:** Always use the provided ladder for accessing the top bunk. Ensure the ladder is securely attached before use. The ladder features extra-wide, deeply grooved steps for enhanced safety.
- **Age Recommendation:** The top bunk is not suitable for children under six years of age.
- **Prohibited Activities:** Do not allow jumping on the bed. Do not attach or hang items from any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check and ensure all connectors and hardware are tight.
- **Compliance:** This bunk bed meets or exceeds all ASTM and US Government safety standards for bunk beds.
- **Proposition 65 Warning:** This product may contain chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Parts List

Before assembly, unpack all components and verify against the included parts list (typically found in the packaging). Common components include:

- Upper and Lower Bed Frames
- Trundle Bed Frame
- Slat Roll Foundations (for all beds)
- Side-Attached Ladder
- Guard Rails
- Hardware Pack (screws, bolts, nuts, etc.)

If any parts are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly. Contact customer support for assistance.

Setup and Assembly Instructions

Assembly of this bunk bed is required. It is recommended that two adults perform the assembly. Clear a spacious area for assembly and keep children and pets away from the assembly area.

1. **Unpack and Organize:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Lay them out on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches. Identify each part using the provided parts list.
2. **Assemble Lower Bed Frame:** Follow the specific diagrams in your packaged instructions to connect the headboard, footboard, and side rails for the lower twin bed. Ensure all connections are secure but do not fully tighten hardware until instructed. The lower bed features a dual center rail support system for the slat foundation.
3. **Assemble Upper Bed Frame:** Similarly, assemble the upper twin bed frame, including its headboard, footboard, and side rails. This bed also utilizes a slat roll foundation with a reinforced center rail support system.
4. **Attach Guard Rails:** Securely attach the guard rails to the upper bunk bed frame as indicated in the diagrams.
5. **Stack Bunk Beds:** Carefully lift and place the assembled upper bed frame onto the lower bed frame. Ensure the connecting pins or mechanisms align and lock securely.
6. **Attach Ladder:** The side-attached ladder can be positioned on either side of the bunk bed. Securely attach the ladder to the upper bunk frame using the provided hardware. Ensure it is stable and does not wobble.
7. **Assemble Trundle Bed:** Assemble the trundle bed frame according to its specific instructions. This typically involves attaching wheels and side panels.
8. **Insert Slats:** Place the slat roll foundations into both the upper and lower bed frames, and the trundle bed. Secure them as per the instructions.
9. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are assembled and aligned, systematically tighten all hardware connections. Do not overtighten.
10. **Placement:** Position the assembled bunk bed against a wall, ensuring there is adequate space around it for safe use.

Operating Instructions

- **Using the Trundle Bed:** The trundle bed is designed to slide out from underneath the lower bunk. Gently pull the trundle bed forward until it is fully extended. To store, push it back underneath the lower bunk until it is flush.

- **Separating into Individual Beds:** This innovative bunk bed system allows the top standard Twin bed to separate from the bottom Twin bed, creating two individual beds. Refer to the specific diagrams in your assembly manual for detailed instructions on how to safely separate the beds. This typically involves disengaging the stacking mechanisms and carefully lowering the top bed.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the cappuccino finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connectors to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain structural integrity and safety.
- **Wood Care:** The bed is constructed from solid wood. Protect it from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.

Troubleshooting

- **Bed Wobbles:** Ensure all hardware is securely tightened. Check that the bed is placed on a level surface.
- **Squeaking Noises:** Squeaking often indicates loose hardware. Retighten all bolts and screws. Applying a small amount of wax or lubricant to metal-on-metal contact points (if applicable) can also help.
- **Trundle Not Sliding Smoothly:** Check the wheels for obstructions or damage. Ensure the track area underneath the bed is clear of debris.
- **Missing or Damaged Parts:** If you discover missing or damaged parts during assembly, do not proceed. Contact customer support immediately for replacements.
