INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Genuine Toyota Visor Assembly, Model 74320-42501-B2. This Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) part is designed for direct fitment, ensuring high quality and compatibility with your vehicle. Please read these instructions carefully before proceeding with installation or use.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety when working on your vehicle. Ensure the vehicle is parked on a level surface with the engine off and the parking brake engaged. If you are unsure about any step, consult a qualified automotive technician. Keep small parts away from children.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 1 x Genuine Toyota Visor Assembly (Model 74320-42501-B2)
- Integrated mounting clips and cover cap

Note: Additional tools for installation are not included.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This section details the steps to replace your existing visor with the new Genuine Toyota Visor Assembly. The process is generally straightforward but requires careful attention to detail.

Tools Required (Not Included):

- Flathead screwdriver or plastic pry tool
- Pliers (optional, for stubborn old clips)
- Rubber mallet (optional, for applying slight force during installation)

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Vehicle:** Ensure the vehicle is off and the area around the visor is clear.

2. **Remove the Old Visor:**

- Carefully use a flathead screwdriver or plastic pry tool to pry off the small cover cap located at the base of the visor's mounting bracket. This cap typically hides the mounting screws or clips.
- Once the cap is removed, you will expose the mounting mechanism. Depending on your vehicle model, this may involve unscrewing screws or releasing clips.
- Gently detach the visor from its mounting point. If there are electrical connections for a vanity light, carefully disconnect them.
- Inspect the ceiling bracket. Ensure any old clips or remnants from the previous visor are completely removed. Pliers may be needed for stubborn old clips.

3. **Install the New Visor:**

- Connect any electrical wiring for the vanity light, if applicable, ensuring a secure connection.
- Align the new visor's mounting arm with the ceiling bracket opening.
- Insert the part of the visor with the clips into the opening first. Apply firm, even pressure. You may hear a "snap" as the clips engage. Some installations might benefit from a light tap with a rubber mallet to ensure the clips fully seat.
- *Important:* Ensure the clips are fully locked into place. If they are not, the visor may not hold securely.
- Once the main mounting arm is secure, snap the outer cover cap back into place over the mounting bracket.
- Test the visor's movement and stability. It should move smoothly but hold its position firmly.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The visor is designed for simple and effective operation.

- **Adjusting Position:** Gently pivot the visor down to block sunlight. It can also be unclipped from its secondary holder (if present) and swung to the side window to block glare.
- **Vanity Mirror:** If equipped, slide open the cover on the underside of the visor to reveal the vanity mirror. The light for the mirror should activate automatically when the cover is opened.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your visor:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the visor surface with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn marks, use a mild automotive interior cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the finish.
- **Mirror Care:** Clean the vanity mirror with a glass cleaner and a soft, lint-free cloth.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the mounting points for any looseness.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Visor does not stay up or is loose.	Mounting clips not fully engaged or damaged during installation.	Re-check installation steps. Ensure clips are securely snapped into the ceiling bracket. If clips are damaged, the visor may need replacement.
Vanity mirror light not working.	Loose electrical connection or bulb issue.	Ensure electrical connection is secure. If the issue persists, the bulb may need replacement (if accessible) or professional inspection.
Visor feels stiff or difficult to move.	New part stiffness or improper alignment.	New visors can be slightly stiff initially; gentle, repeated movement should loosen it. Ensure it's correctly aligned in its mounting.
