1. INTRODUCTION

The Microsoft All-in-One Media Keyboard is a versatile wireless keyboard designed for seamless control of your Windows PC connected to a TV. It features an integrated multi-touch trackpad, customizable media hotkeys, and a durable, spill-resistant design, making it ideal for home entertainment and various computing needs.

This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your keyboard to ensure optimal performance.

2. KEY FEATURES

3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1. System Requirements

- Operating System: Windows 8.1, Windows 8, Windows RT 8.1, Windows RT, and Windows 7.
- USB Port: Required for the proprietary 2.4 GHz wireless receiver.
- Hard Drive Space: 150 MB for Windows.
- Batteries: 2 AAA alkaline batteries (included).

3.2. What's in the Box

- Microsoft All-in-One Media Keyboard
- USB Wireless Receiver
- 2 AAA Alkaline Batteries

3.3. Installing Batteries and USB Receiver

1. **Open the Battery Compartment:** Locate the battery compartment cover on the underside of the keyboard. Slide or lift the cover to open it.

2. **Insert Batteries:** Insert the two included AAA alkaline batteries into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity (+/-) as indicated inside the compartment.
3. **Retrieve USB Receiver:** The USB wireless receiver is typically stored inside the battery compartment for safekeeping. Carefully remove it.
4. **Close the Compartment:** Replace the battery compartment cover securely.
5. **Connect USB Receiver:** Plug the USB wireless receiver into an available USB port on your Windows PC, Smart TV, or compatible device. The device should automatically detect the keyboard.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1. Basic Usage

- **Typing:** Use the full-size QWERTY keyboard for comfortable typing.
- **Trackpad:** The integrated multi-touch trackpad allows for intuitive cursor control. Use single-finger gestures for pointing and clicking, and two-finger gestures for scrolling.
- **Left/Right Click Buttons:** The trackpad features dedicated left and right click buttons at the bottom. Additionally, a left-click button is located on the top-left corner of the keyboard for convenient thumb operation.

4.2. Media Controls and Hotkeys

- **Multimedia Keys:** The top row of keys includes dedicated multimedia controls (play/pause, skip, volume up/down/mute) for easy management of your audio and video content.
- **Customizable Hotkeys:** Utilize the customizable hotkeys to quickly launch your favorite applications, websites, or media functions. Refer to your operating system's settings or Microsoft's keyboard software for customization options.
- **Volume Slider:** A dedicated volume slider is located on the left side of the keyboard for quick audio adjustments.

4.3. Power Management

- **On/Off Switch:** To conserve battery life, use the power switch located on the side of the keyboard to turn it off when not in use.
- **Battery Indicator:** The keyboard may feature a low battery indicator light. Replace batteries when the indicator signals low power.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** The spill-resistant design allows for easy cleaning. Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe down the surface. For spills, gently wipe away the liquid and allow the keyboard to air dry completely before reuse.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace the two AAA batteries when the low battery indicator appears or when performance degrades. Ensure correct polarity during installation.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, turn off the keyboard and store it in a dry, cool place.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|---------------------------------|-------------------------------------|---|
| Keyboard not responding | Low or dead batteries | Replace batteries. |
| | USB receiver not properly connected | Ensure USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port. |
| | Out of range | Move closer to the USB receiver (within 10 meters). |
| | Interference | Move the keyboard and receiver away from other wireless devices or large metal objects. |
| Trackpad not working correctly | Dirty trackpad surface | Clean the trackpad surface with a soft, damp cloth. |
| | Software/driver issue | Ensure your operating system drivers are up to date. |
| Keys are sticky or unresponsive | Spill residue | Clean the keyboard thoroughly. |
| | Debris under keys | For persistent issues, contact Microsoft Support. |
