# INTRODUCTION

The Capresso 425 On-the-Go Personal Coffee Maker is designed for convenience, allowing you to brew fresh coffee directly into a 16-ounce stainless steel travel mug. Its compact design and ease of use make it ideal for personal use at home, in the office, or while traveling.

# IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- · Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against fire, electric shock, and injury to persons, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may result in fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then
  remove plug from wall outlet.
- · Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Scalding may occur if the lid is removed during the brewing cycle.

### PARTS AND COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the main parts of your Capresso On-the-Go Personal Coffee Maker:

- Water Reservoir: Located at the top, for filling with water.
- Lid: Covers the water reservoir and filter basket.
- Filter Basket: Holds the permanent filter or disposable paper filter.
- Permanent Filter: Reusable filter for ground coffee.
- Brewing Head: Dispenses hot water over the coffee grounds.
- Travel Mug: 16-ounce stainless steel insulated mug designed to fit directly under the brewing head.
- Power Button: Located on the front base, illuminates when brewing.
- Drip Tray: Removable tray for easy cleaning.

# SETUP AND FIRST USE

- 1. Unpacking: Carefully unpack all parts and remove any packaging materials.
- 2. **Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the travel mug, permanent filter, and filter basket in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Wipe the exterior of the coffee maker with a damp cloth.
- 3. Initial Rinse Cycle:
  - Fill the water reservoir with fresh cold water up to the 16 oz mark.
  - Place the empty travel mug (or another mug up to 7" tall) on the drip tray.

- Press the power button. The light will illuminate, and the unit will begin to heat and dispense hot water.
- Allow the full cycle to complete. Discard the hot water. This cleans the internal components and removes any
  manufacturing residue.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Follow these steps to brew a perfect cup of coffee:

### 1. Prepare Coffee Grounds:

- Open the lid of the coffee maker.
- Place the permanent filter into the filter basket. If using a paper filter, place a #1 cone paper filter inside the permanent filter.
- Add your desired amount of ground coffee (approximately 2-3 tablespoons for 16 oz, adjust to taste). Ensure
  the grounds are not too fine to prevent overflow.
- · Close the lid securely.

#### 2. Add Water:

- Fill the travel mug with fresh, cold water up to the desired level (maximum 16 oz).
- Pour the water from the travel mug into the water reservoir. Do not overfill.
- 3. **Position Mug:** Place the empty travel mug (or your own mug up to 7" tall) onto the drip tray, ensuring it is centered under the brewing head.

#### 4. Start Brewing:

- Plug the coffee maker into a standard 110V AC outlet.
- Press the power button located on the front base. The button will illuminate blue, indicating the brewing cycle
  has started.
- The coffee maker will heat the water and brew the coffee directly into your mug. The brewing process is quick, typically taking less than 5 minutes.
- Once brewing is complete, the power button light will turn off. Wait a few moments for any remaining drips to cease before removing the mug.
- 5. Enjoy Your Coffee: Carefully remove the hot travel mug and enjoy your freshly brewed coffee.

### Maintenance and Cleaning

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your coffee maker.

# • Daily Cleaning:

- Unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely.
- Remove the filter basket and permanent filter. Discard used coffee grounds.
- Wash the travel mug, filter basket, and permanent filter in warm, soapy water. These parts are also dishwasher safe (top rack recommended).
- Wipe the exterior of the coffee maker with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- Empty and clean the drip tray.

- **Decalcifying (As Needed):** Mineral deposits from water can affect performance. Decalcify every 2-3 months, or more frequently with hard water.
  - Mix 1 oz (2 tablespoons) of Capresso Cleaning Solution with 16 oz of water, or use 2 oz (4 tablespoons) of white vinegar with 16 oz of water.
  - Pour the solution into the water reservoir.
  - Place an empty mug on the drip tray.
  - Press the power button and allow the full cycle to complete.
  - After the cycle, discard the solution.
  - Run two full cycles with fresh, cold water to rinse the system thoroughly.

# **Troubleshooting**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Coffee does not brew.	No water in reservoir; unit not plugged in; power button not pressed.	Fill water reservoir; ensure unit is plugged in; press power button.
Coffee overflows from filter basket.	Too much coffee grounds; coffee grounds too fine; unit needs decalcifying.	Reduce amount of coffee; use coarser grind; decalcify the unit.
Coffee is weak.	Not enough coffee grounds; too much water.	Increase coffee grounds; use less water.
Coffee is not hot enough.	Unit needs decalcifying.	Decalcify the unit.
