# Weber #62799 Natural Gas 3 Burner Tube Set Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and effective installation, operation, and maintenance of your Weber #62799 Natural Gas (NG) 3 Burner Tube Set. This set is designed as a replacement part for compatible Weber natural gas grills. Please read all instructions carefully before proceeding with installation or use.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always ensure the grill is completely cool and the gas supply is turned off and disconnected before attempting any installation or maintenance.
- Wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves, to protect your hands during installation.
- Keep children and pets away from the work area.
- After installation, always check for gas leaks using a soapy water solution before lighting the grill. Never use an open flame to check for leaks.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present in your package:

- 3 x Main Burner Tubes
- Fastening Hardware (screws/bolts)
- Instruction Sheet (this document)

*Note: A sear burner for 330 models is not included in this set and must be purchased separately if required.*

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

---

Follow these steps to replace your grill's burner tubes:

1. **Prepare the Grill:** Ensure your grill is completely cool. Turn off the gas supply at the source and disconnect the natural gas line from the grill.
2. **Remove Grill Grates and Flavorizer Bars:** Carefully lift out the cooking grates and flavorizer bars to expose the existing burner tubes.
3. **Disconnect Igniter Wires (if applicable):** If your grill has igniter electrodes attached to the burner tubes, gently disconnect the wires. Note their positions for reattachment.
4. **Remove Old Burner Tubes:** Locate the screws or bolts securing the burner tubes at the back of the firebox. Remove these fasteners. Carefully slide the old burner tubes out of the valve orifices at the front of the grill. Old bolts may be corroded and difficult to remove; patience is advised.
5. **Install New Burner Tubes:** Carefully insert the new Weber #62799 burner tubes into the valve orifices. Ensure they are properly seated. Align the rear of the burner tubes with the mounting holes in the firebox.
6. **Secure Burner Tubes:** Use the new fastening hardware provided to secure the burner tubes at the rear of the firebox. Do not overtighten.
7. **Reconnect Igniter Wires:** Reattach any igniter wires to their respective electrodes on the new burner tubes.
8. **Replace Components:** Place the flavorizer bars and cooking grates back into their original positions.
9. **Reconnect Gas Supply and Check for Leaks:** Reconnect the natural gas line to the grill. Turn on the gas supply slowly. Apply a soapy water solution to all gas connections. If bubbles appear, turn off the gas immediately and tighten the connection. Repeat until no bubbles are observed.

## OPERATING WITH NEW BURNERS

---

Once the new burner tubes are installed and leak-checked, you can operate your grill as usual. Refer to

your grill's main instruction manual for specific lighting procedures. Ensure that the flames appear even and blue, indicating proper gas flow and combustion.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance helps prolong the life and performance of your burner tubes:

- **Cleaning Burner Ports:** Periodically, with the gas supply off and the grill cool, use a clean wire brush or a stiff wire to clear any debris from the burner ports. This ensures even flame distribution.
- **Inspect for Damage:** Regularly inspect the burner tubes for signs of corrosion, cracks, or blockages. Replace any damaged burner tubes promptly.
- **Gas Line Inspection:** Annually, inspect the gas supply line for cracks, cuts, or excessive wear. Replace if any damage is found.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues after installing the new burner tubes, consider the following:

- **Uneven or Low Flame:**
  - *Cause:* Clogged burner ports or spider webs/insect nests inside the burner tube.
  - *Solution:* Turn off gas, allow grill to cool, remove burner tubes, and clean ports thoroughly with a wire brush. Inspect the inside of the tubes for obstructions.
- **No Flame:**
  - *Cause:* Gas supply off, gas line obstruction, or igniter malfunction.
  - *Solution:* Check that the gas supply is fully open. Ensure the gas line is not kinked. Verify igniter spark (refer to grill manual). Re-check all gas connections for leaks.
- **Yellow or Orange Flames:**
  - *Cause:* Improper air-to-gas mixture, often due to burner port blockages or issues with the air shutter (if adjustable).
  - *Solution:* Clean burner ports. If your grill has adjustable air shutters, consult your grill's manual for proper adjustment.


