SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Your Sterilite 3-Drawer Rolling Storage Cart comes with optional casters for enhanced mobility. Follow these steps to set up your cart:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Ensure you have the main cart frame, three drawers, and four casters.
2. **Attach Casters (Optional):** If you wish to use the cart with wheels, locate the four caster attachment points on the bottom of the cart frame. Firmly push each caster into its designated hole until it clicks securely into place. Ensure all casters are fully inserted for stability.
3. **Insert Drawers:** Slide each of the three clear drawers into their respective slots in the cart frame. Ensure they slide smoothly and are properly aligned.
4. **Placement:** Position the assembled cart in your desired location. If casters are attached, you can easily roll it into place.

Note: The cart can be used without casters for stationary storage. Simply omit step 2.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Opening Drawers:** Use the integrated handle on the front of each drawer to pull it open. The clear design allows you to see contents before opening.
- **Closing Drawers:** Gently push the drawer back into the frame until it is fully closed. The drawer stop feature prevents drawers from being pulled out completely by accident.
- **Loading Contents:** Place lightweight items into the drawers. Be mindful of the weight in each drawer and avoid overloading to ensure smooth operation and longevity of the product.
- **Mobility:** If casters are installed, the cart can be easily rolled across flat surfaces to reposition it as needed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drawers are difficult to open/close.	Overloaded drawer; debris in tracks; misaligned drawer.	Reduce contents in the drawer. Check tracks for obstructions and clean if necessary. Re-insert the drawer, ensuring it is properly aligned.
Cart does not roll smoothly.	Casters are not fully inserted; debris in casters; uneven surface.	Ensure all casters are pushed in completely. Clean any hair or debris from the caster wheels. Move the cart to a flat, even surface.
Drawer falls out easily.	Drawer stop mechanism is damaged or not engaged.	Inspect the drawer and frame for any damage to the drawer stop. If damaged, contact customer support.
