1. INTRODUCTION

The Laurastar Lift Plus is a compact and portable 3-in-1 steam generator designed to iron, steam, and purify your clothes. Its unique design allows for use on an ironing board or for vertical steaming of garments on a hanger. Featuring advanced technologies such as pulse steam and the 3D active soleplate, it ensures optimal steam distribution and professional results.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the Laurastar Lift Plus to ensure safe operation and prevent injury or damage.

- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure the appliance is connected to a 120-volt power supply. Always unplug the unit from the electrical outlet when not in use, before filling or emptying the water tank, and before cleaning. Do not operate with a damaged cord or plug.
- **Steam Hazard:** The iron produces hot steam. Keep hands and body away from the steam jet. Do not direct steam at people or pets. Allow the iron to cool completely before storing.
- **Water Usage:** Use only demineralized or distilled water in the water tank. Do not add perfumes, vinegar, starch, descaling agents, or other chemicals to the water tank, as this can damage the appliance and void the warranty.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep the appliance out of reach of children and pets. Do not leave the iron unattended while it is hot or connected to power.
- **Placement:** Place the steam generator on a stable, heat-resistant surface. Ensure the steam hose is not kinked or obstructed during use.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Key Features:

- **Pulse Steam:** Steam is diffused in short, intermittent pulses for optimal distribution and perfect results on various fabrics.
- **3D Active Soleplate:** Ensures even steam diffusion, eliminating creases in a single movement and refreshing fabric fibers.
- **Professional Iron:** Diffuses ultra-fine, powerful steam suitable for all fabrics, enabling both horizontal and vertical steaming.
- **Laurastar DMS (Dry Microfine Steam):** Purifies fabrics, removing allergens and germs.
- **Dual-Shut-Off Mode:** Offers a 10-minute auto-shut-off for safety or a continuous-on mode for extended use.
- **Portability:** Lightweight design with an integrated handle for easy transport and storage.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Laurastar Lift Plus for the first time or after storage.

1. **Unpack the Unit:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Position the Unit:** Place the Laurastar Lift Plus on a flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface, such as an ironing board or a sturdy table.
3. **Fill the Water Tank:** Remove the water tank (refer to Figure 3.3). Fill it with demineralized or distilled water up to the MAX line. Insert the anti-scale cartridge into the tank if not already installed. Reinsert the water tank into the unit.
4. **Connect the Iron:** Ensure the iron is securely connected to the steam generator via the steam hose.
5. **Plug In:** Insert the power cord into a grounded 120-volt electrical outlet.
6. **Initial Heating:** Press the power button. The indicator light will flash while the unit heats up. It will become steady when ready for use (approximately 3 minutes).

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Learn how to effectively use your Laurastar Lift Plus for various garment care needs.

5.1. Powering On and Off

- **To Power On:** Press the main power button located on the unit. The indicator light will flash during heating and turn solid when ready.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the main power button until the unit shuts down.
- **Auto-Shut-Off:** The unit features a 10-minute auto-shut-off mode for safety. To bypass this and enable continuous operation, press and hold the power button until it flashes red, then release.

5.2. Ironing with Steam






Figure 5.2: Vertical steaming with Laurastar Lift Plus. The image demonstrates the ability to steam garments directly on a hanger, ideal for delicate fabrics or quick touch-ups.

- **Horizontal Ironing:** Place the garment on an ironing board. Press the steam button on the iron handle to release pulse steam. Glide the iron smoothly over the fabric. The 3D active soleplate ensures efficient crease removal.
- **Vertical Steaming:** Hang the garment on a hanger (refer to Figure 5.2). Hold the iron a few inches away from the fabric and press the steam button. Move the iron up and down the garment to release wrinkles and refresh the fabric. This method is ideal for delicate fabrics, suits, or drapes.
- **Protective Soleplate:** For delicate fabrics like silk or synthetics, attach the included protective soleplate to the iron. This prevents scorching and provides a gentler ironing experience.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Laurastar Lift Plus.

- **Emptying the Water Tank:** After each use, or before extended storage, empty any remaining water from the

tank. Ensure the unit is unplugged and cool.

- **Cleaning the Soleplate:** If the soleplate becomes dirty, clean it with a damp cloth after the iron has cooled down. Do not use abrasive cleaners or metallic scouring pads.
- **Replacing the Anti-Scale Cartridge:** The anti-scale cartridge helps prevent mineral buildup. Replace it when the indicator light signals or as recommended by the manufacturer (typically every few months depending on water hardness and usage). Refer to the cartridge packaging for specific instructions.
- **Storage:** Once the unit has cooled completely, wrap the power cord and steam hose neatly. The compact design allows for easy storage.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Laurastar Lift Plus, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam or insufficient steam	Water tank empty; Unit not heated sufficiently; Anti-scale cartridge needs replacement; Steam hose kinked.	Fill water tank; Wait for indicator light to be solid; Replace anti-scale cartridge; Straighten steam hose.
Water leaking from iron	Iron not hot enough; Condensation in hose; Overfilling water tank.	Allow iron to heat fully; Hold iron away from garment and press steam button until only steam comes out; Do not overfill water tank.
Unit does not turn on	Not plugged in; Power outlet issue; Unit in auto-shut-off mode.	Check power cord connection; Test outlet with another appliance; Press power button to reactivate.
Iron soleplate is dirty	Residue from fabrics or starch.	Clean cooled soleplate with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive materials.
