INTRODUCTION

- RemoteTalk Cable
- Carrying Case

SETUP

Setting up your Beats Solo2 headphones is straightforward. These are wired headphones, requiring a direct connection to your audio source.

- 1. Unfold Headphones:** Gently unfold the headphones from their compact, folded position. The hinges are designed for durability.
- 2. Connect RemoteTalk Cable:** Insert the 3.5mm jack of the RemoteTalk cable into the audio port on the left earcup of the headphones. Ensure it is fully inserted for a secure connection.
- 3. Connect to Audio Source:** Insert the other end of the RemoteTalk cable into the 3.5mm audio output jack of your device (e.g., smartphone, tablet, computer, MP3 player).
- 4. Adjust Fit:** Place the headphones on your head and adjust the headband sliders on both sides to achieve a comfortable and secure fit. The earcups should fully cover your ears or rest comfortably on them, depending on your preference.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The RemoteTalk cable provides convenient control over your music and calls without needing to access your device directly.

Music Control:

- **Play/Pause:** Press the center button once.
- **Next Track:** Press the center button twice quickly.
- **Previous Track:** Press the center button three times quickly.
- **Fast Forward:** Press the center button twice quickly and hold on the second press.
- **Rewind:** Press the center button three times quickly and hold on the third press.

Call Control:

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the center button once.
- **Decline Call:** Press and hold the center button for two seconds.
- **Switch Between Calls:** During a call, press the center button once to switch to an incoming call or another active call. Press again to switch back.

Note: Volume control functionality via the RemoteTalk cable may vary depending on your device's operating system (e.g., Android devices may not support volume control).

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life and maintain the performance of your Beats Solo2 headphones.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the earcups and headband. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or chemical solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, fold the headphones and store them in the provided carrying case to protect them from dust, scratches, and impacts.
- **Avoid Moisture:** Keep the headphones away from water and excessive moisture. They are not waterproof.
- **Cable Care:** Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling on the RemoteTalk cable to prevent damage.
- **Temperature:** Do not expose the headphones to extreme temperatures (hot or cold).

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Beats Solo2 headphones, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No sound or intermittent sound	Ensure the RemoteTalk cable is fully inserted into both the headphones and the audio source. Check the volume level on your audio source. Test with a different audio source or a different 3.5mm cable to rule out cable or device issues. Clean the audio jacks on both the headphones and the device.
Microphone not working	Ensure the RemoteTalk cable is securely connected. Verify that your device's settings allow microphone input from the connected headphones. Test the microphone with a different application or device.
RemoteTalk controls not responding	Ensure the cable is fully inserted. Some functions (e.g., volume) may not be compatible with all devices, especially non-Apple devices. Test the controls with a different compatible device.
