1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Before using your Sevylor Colorado Inflatable Fishing Kayak, please read and understand all safety instructions. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or property damage.

- Always wear a U.S. Coast Guard-approved personal flotation device (PFD).
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of the kayak. This kayak is designed for two persons.
- Never use the kayak under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Be aware of weather conditions and water currents. Avoid using the kayak in strong winds, rough waters, or during storms.
- Inform someone of your float plan, including your destination and estimated return time.
- Inspect the kayak for damage or leaks before each use.
- Keep sharp objects away from the kayak's surface to prevent punctures.
- Ensure all air chambers are properly inflated to the recommended pressure.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in your package:

- Sevylor Colorado Inflatable Fishing Kayak (Model: 2000014133)
- Two (2) Adjustable Seats
- Two (2) Paddles
- Rod Holders
- Carry Handle
- Repair Kit

- Hand Pump with Pressure Gauge (if included with specific model variant)
- Footrests (if included)

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Unfolding the Kayak

Unroll the kayak on a clean, flat surface, free from sharp objects. Ensure the kayak is fully extended before proceeding to inflation.

3.2 Inflation

Locate the inflation valves on the kayak. The Sevylor Colorado features multiple air chambers for safety. Inflate the chambers in the recommended sequence (usually marked 1, 2, 3 on the valves) using the provided hand pump. Use the pressure gauge to ensure the kayak is inflated to the correct PSI, avoiding over-inflation.

3.3 Seat and Footrest Installation

Attach the adjustable seats to the designated Velcro strips on the kayak floor. Position them for optimal comfort and balance. If included, slide the footrests under the canvas straps on the kayak floor to provide support for your feet during paddling.

3.4 Accessory Installation (Rod Holders, Camera Mounts)

The kayak is equipped with various attachment points for accessories. Secure the rod holders into their designated slots. If using a camera mount, attach it to the appropriate mounting base. Ensure all accessories are firmly secured before launching.

3.5 Paddle Assembly

Assemble the two-piece paddles by connecting the shaft sections. Ensure they are securely locked in place. The kayak also features paddle holders to keep your paddles secure when not in use.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Launching and Landing

Carefully move the inflated kayak to the water's edge. Ensure the water is deep enough to avoid scraping the bottom. Enter the kayak one person at a time, maintaining balance. For landing, approach the shore slowly and exit carefully, ensuring the kayak is stable.

4.2 Paddling Techniques

Hold the paddle with both hands, slightly wider than shoulder-width apart. Use your core muscles to rotate and propel the kayak forward. For steering, apply more force on one side or use sweep strokes. The kayak is designed for stability, making it suitable for various paddling styles.

4.3 Environmental Considerations

The Sevylor Colorado is ideal for lake adventures. In windy conditions, the kayak may be more susceptible to drifting due to its inflatable nature. Consider using an anchor if fishing in windy areas. Always be aware of your surroundings and other watercraft.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning

After each use, rinse the kayak with fresh water to remove dirt, sand, and salt. Use mild soap and water for

stubborn stains. Ensure the kayak is completely dry before deflating and storing to prevent mildew.

5.2 Storage

Deflate the kayak completely and fold it neatly. Store it in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on top of the folded kayak.

5.3 Repairs

In case of minor punctures, use the provided repair kit. Follow the instructions in the kit for proper patch application. For larger damage or if unsure, consult a professional repair service.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Kayak losing air:** Check all inflation valves to ensure they are securely closed. Inspect the kayak surface for punctures. Use soapy water to locate small leaks by looking for bubbles.
- **Difficulty steering:** Ensure the rudders (if applicable) are properly installed and not damaged. Adjust your paddling technique for more effective steering.
- **Kayak feels unstable:** Verify that all air chambers are inflated to the recommended pressure. Distribute weight evenly within the kayak.
