1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Before operating the Viva Fitness T-1500 Commercial Treadmill, please read and understand all instructions in this manual. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Consult your physician before beginning any exercise program, especially if you have pre-existing health conditions.
- Keep children and pets away from the treadmill during operation.
- Place the treadmill on a solid, level surface with adequate clearance around it (at least 2 meters at the rear and 0.5 meters on each side).
- Ensure the safety key is properly attached to your clothing before starting the treadmill. In case of an emergency, pulling the safety key will immediately stop the machine.
- Do not operate the treadmill if it has a damaged cord or plug, or if it is not working properly.
- The maximum user weight for this treadmill is 150 kg. Do not exceed this limit.
- Wear appropriate athletic footwear and clothing.
- Always hold the handrails when starting or stopping the treadmill, or when making speed/incline adjustments.
- Unplug the treadmill from the power outlet when not in use, before cleaning, and before performing any maintenance.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Carefully unpack all components and verify that you have received the following items:

- Viva Fitness T-1500 Commercial Treadmill main frame
- Console panel
- Handrails

- Safety key
- Assembly hardware kit
- Installation manual

If any parts are missing or damaged, please contact customer support immediately.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The Viva Fitness T-1500 Commercial Treadmill requires assembly. Please follow the detailed instructions provided in the included installation manual. It is recommended to have two people for assembly due to the size and weight of the components.

Key Assembly Steps:

1. Unpack all components and lay them out in an open area.
2. Attach the uprights to the base frame.
3. Secure the console mast and console panel.
4. Connect all necessary cables as indicated in the installation manual.
5. Attach the handrails.
6. Ensure all bolts and nuts are securely tightened before use.

For optimal performance and safety, ensure the treadmill is placed on a stable, flat surface. The running surface measures 22" x 60" with a 3mm thick belt.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details how to operate your Viva Fitness T-1500 Commercial Treadmill.

4.1 Console Overview

The treadmill features an easy navigation console panel with an LCD display. This display shows key workout metrics such as Heart Rate, Speed, and Incline. The console also includes buttons for adjusting speed, incline, and selecting workout programs.

4.2 Starting a Workout

1. Plug the treadmill into a grounded electrical outlet.

2. Stand on the side rails of the treadmill.
3. Attach the safety key clip to your clothing and insert the safety key into its designated slot on the console. The display will illuminate.
4. Press the **START** button to begin the workout. The belt will start moving at a low speed.

4.3 Adjusting Speed and Incline

- **Speed:** Use the **SPEED +** and **SPEED -** buttons on the console or handrails to increase or decrease the running speed. The maximum speed is 22 kilometers per hour.
- **Incline:** Use the **INCLINE +** and **INCLINE -** buttons to adjust the incline level. The maximum incline percentage is 15.

4.4 Using Workout Programs

The T-1500 offers 8 pre-set workout programs. Refer to the console's specific instructions for navigating and selecting these programs. These programs are designed to tailor your fitness goal by implementing either fundamental or enhanced workout routines.

4.5 Monitoring Metrics

During your workout, the LCD display will show real-time data for:

- **Heart Rate:** Measured via sensors on the handrails.
- **Speed:** Current belt speed.
- **Incline:** Current incline level.

4.6 Stopping the Treadmill

- **Normal Stop:** Press the **STOP** button on the console. The belt will gradually slow down and stop.
- **Emergency Stop:** Pull the safety key from the console. The treadmill will stop immediately.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your treadmill.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the console and other surfaces with a damp cloth after each use. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Belt Lubrication:** The running belt requires periodic lubrication. Refer to the installation manual for specific instructions on how and when to lubricate the belt.
- **Belt Tension and Alignment:** Check the running belt tension and alignment regularly. If the belt feels loose or is drifting to one side, adjust it according to the instructions in the installation manual.
- **Power Cord Inspection:** Periodically inspect the power cord for any damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your treadmill.

- **Treadmill does not power on:**
 - Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet.

- Check if the safety key is properly inserted into the console.
- Verify the circuit breaker on the treadmill (if present) has not tripped.

- **Running belt slips or hesitates:**

- The running belt may need tensioning. Refer to the installation manual for adjustment instructions.
- The belt may require lubrication.

- **Unusual noises during operation:**

- Ensure all assembly bolts are tightened.
- Check for any foreign objects under the belt or near the motor cover.
- If the noise persists, contact customer support.
