# Moulinex Ultracompact Electric Juicer (Model PC120870) - Instruction Manual

Comprehensive guide for setup, operation, and maintenance of your Moulinex juicer.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Moulinex Ultracompact Electric Juicer. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use of your appliance. Please read it thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

This electric juicer is designed for extracting juice from citrus fruits such as oranges, lemons, and grapefruits. Its compact design makes it suitable for everyday use.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions before using the appliance.
- Do not immerse the motor unit in water or other liquids.
- Ensure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to your mains voltage before connecting.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Always ensure the appliance is properly assembled before operation.

- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

### 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

---

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your Moulinex Ultracompact Electric Juicer:

1. Protective Lid
2. Juicing Cone (Double Rotation)
3. Pulp Filter
4. Juice Collector (with measurement markings)
5. Motor Unit / Base
6. Power Cord with Cord Storage

## 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, wash all removable parts (lid, cone, filter, juice collector) in warm soapy water, rinse thoroughly, and dry. The motor unit should only be wiped with a damp cloth.

1. Place the motor unit on a stable, flat, and dry surface.
2. Unwind the power cord from the cord storage area located on the underside of the base.
3. Place the juice collector onto the motor unit, ensuring it is seated correctly.
4. Insert the pulp filter into the juice collector.
5. Place the juicing cone onto the shaft in the center of the filter.
6. The appliance is now assembled and ready for use.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to extract juice from citrus fruits:

1. Ensure the juicer is properly assembled and plugged into a suitable electrical outlet.
2. Cut the citrus fruit (e.g., orange, lemon) in half.
3. Place one half of the fruit onto the juicing cone.
4. Apply gentle downward pressure on the fruit. The motor will automatically start.
5. The juicing cone features a double rotation mechanism to maximize juice extraction.
6. Continue pressing until all juice is extracted from the fruit half.
7. Release pressure to stop the motor.
8. Repeat with remaining fruit halves.
9. The juice will collect in the juice collector below the filter. The collector has measurement markings up to 50 cl (0.5 L).
10. Once juicing is complete, unplug the appliance.

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning ensures the longevity and hygiene of your juicer. Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.

1. Disassemble the juicer by removing the lid, juicing cone, and pulp filter, then lifting the juice collector from the motor unit.
2. **Removable Parts:** The protective lid, juicing cone, pulp filter, and juice collector are dishwasher safe or can be washed by hand in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry immediately.
3. **Motor Unit:** Wipe the motor unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the motor unit in water or any other liquid.
4. Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing the appliance.
5. For storage, place the protective lid over the juicing cone and filter assembly.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem                         | Possible Cause  | Solution  |
|---------------------------------|---|---|
| Juicer does not start.          | Not plugged in; insufficient pressure on fruit; power outage.         | Ensure appliance is plugged in. Apply firm, consistent pressure on the fruit. Check household power supply. |
| Motor runs slowly or struggles. | Too much pressure applied; too much pulp accumulated; fruit too hard. | Reduce pressure. Clean the pulp filter. Use ripe citrus fruits.   |
| Juice leaks from the base.      | Juice collector not properly seated; overfilled juice collector.      | Ensure juice collector is correctly placed on the motor unit. Do not exceed the maximum fill line (450 ml). |
| Excessive pulp in juice.        | Pulp filter clogged or not properly installed.                        | Clean the pulp filter thoroughly. Ensure the filter is correctly seated.                                    |
