1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP

Before beginning your first project, ensure all components are present and familiarize yourself with the loom's structure.

3.1 Assembling the Loom

- 1. Prepare the Loom:** Ensure the open side of the pegs on the loom are facing away from you for standard bracelet patterns.
- 2. First Band:** Take one rubber band, twist it into a figure-eight, and place it across two pegs.
- 3. Second Band:** Place another rubber band straight across the next two pegs (no twist).
- 4. Continue Placing Bands:** Repeat step 3, placing bands in a straight line along the loom until you reach the desired length.
- 5. Looping:** Using the hook tool, reach into the first peg with three bands. Grab the bottom band, pull it over the peg, and release it.
- 6. Continue Looping:** Move to the next peg. Reach into the peg, grab the bottom band, pull it over, and release. Continue this process along the entire length of your bracelet.

7. **Securing the Bracelet:** Once all bands are looped, carefully remove the bracelet from the loom. Attach a C-clip to the last looped band and connect it to the first figure-eight band to form a closed loop.

4.2 Using the Mini Loom

The mini loom is ideal for quick, simple designs or for creating smaller items like rings or charms.

1. Place a rubber band twisted into a figure-eight on the two pegs of the mini loom.
2. Place a second rubber band straight across the two pegs.
3. Use the hook tool to pull the bottom band over the top band and off the pegs.
4. Add another band straight across and repeat the looping process until the desired length is achieved.
5. Secure with a C-clip.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper care of your Rainbow Loom kit will ensure its longevity and continued enjoyment.

5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the loom and hook tool with a soft, damp cloth if they become dirty.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the plastic.

5.2 Storage

- Store rubber bands in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent degradation.
- Keep all components in the original packaging or a suitable storage container to prevent loss and damage.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Solution
Rubber bands breaking easily.	Ensure you are using authentic Rainbow Loom bands. Store bands away from heat and direct sunlight. Avoid overstretching bands.
Difficulty looping bands.	Ensure the hook tool is properly inserted under the correct bands. Watch instructional videos for visual guidance. Practice simple patterns first.
Loom pegs breaking.	Apply gentle pressure when placing and looping bands. Avoid excessive force. Ensure the loom is on a stable surface.
Finished bracelet is too loose or too tight.	Adjust the number of bands used to match the desired length. For a tighter fit, use fewer bands; for a looser fit, use more.
