Disney Frozen Memory Match Game Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the Disney Frozen Memory Match Game. This classic game of matching features your favorite characters from Disney's Frozen, designed for players aged 5 to 9 years. The game includes 72 durable cards for hours of engaging play.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

- 72 Disney Frozen Memory Match Game Cards

Each card features a unique image of characters or scenes from the Disney Frozen movie. The set contains pairs of identical images.

SETUP

1. **Prepare the Playing Area:** Choose a flat, clear surface large enough to spread out all the cards.
2. **Shuffle the Cards:** Thoroughly shuffle all 72 cards.
3. **Arrange the Cards:** Place all cards face down in a grid pattern (e.g., 6 rows of 12 cards, or 8 rows of 9 cards). Ensure there is some space between cards for easy turning.
4. **Player Seating:** Players should sit around the playing area so everyone can easily reach the cards.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (HOW TO PLAY)

The objective of the Disney Frozen Memory Match Game is to collect the most pairs of matching cards.

1. **Starting the Game:** The youngest player typically goes first, and play proceeds clockwise.
2. **Player's Turn:** On your turn, flip over two cards, one at a time, to reveal their images.
3. **Matching Cards:**

- If the two cards you flipped over have identical images, you have made a match! Keep the pair of cards and take another turn.
 - If the two cards do not match, turn them back face down in their original positions. Your turn then ends, and the next player takes their turn.
4. **Remembering Card Locations:** Pay close attention to the images on the cards and their locations, even when other players are taking their turns. This will help you find matches later.
 5. **Ending the Game:** The game ends when all pairs of cards have been found and collected.
 6. **Determining the Winner:** The player with the most pairs of matching cards at the end of the game is the winner.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** If cards become dirty, gently wipe them with a dry, soft cloth. Avoid using liquids or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the card material or artwork.
- **Storage:** Store the cards in their original box or a suitable container to protect them from dust, moisture, and bending. Keep them in a cool, dry place.
- **Handling:** Handle cards with clean, dry hands to prevent smudges and wear.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Lost Cards:** If cards are lost, the game can still be played with the remaining cards. Simply ensure that for each image, there is a matching pair available. If a pair is incomplete, remove the single card from play.
- **Difficulty for Younger Players:** For younger children (below the recommended age or those new to

memory games), reduce the number of cards used. Start with 10-12 pairs and gradually increase as their memory skills improve.

- **Cards Not Lying Flat:** If cards are slightly bent, place them under a heavy, flat object for a few hours to help flatten them.
