# Calibre Cloud Pro User Manual

Your guide to managing and accessing your ebook library.

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Calibre Cloud Pro is an application designed to provide convenient access to your Calibre ebook library from various devices via cloud storage services. - **Slow Performance:**

- A large library may take longer to load and sync.
- Ensure you have a strong and stable internet connection.
- Clear the application's cache through your device settings if available.

- **Cloud Service Connection Issues:**

- Log out and then log back into your cloud service account within the Calibre Cloud Pro app.
- Check the status of your cloud service provider for any reported outages.
