Can Vinyl Album Instruction Manual

Model: XSPOON28

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper handling, playback, and care of your **Can** vinyl album, Model **XSPOON28**. This European 180-gram LP pressing, released in 2014, offers a high-quality audio experience. Following these guidelines will help ensure the longevity of your record and preserve its sound fidelity.



2. SETUP AND PREPARATION

- Unpacking:** Carefully remove the vinyl record from its outer sleeve and inner dust jacket. Handle the record by its edges or the label area to avoid touching the grooves.
- Turtable Preparation:** Ensure your turntable is level and the stylus (needle) is clean. Verify that the tracking force and anti-skate settings are correctly adjusted according to your turntable's manufacturer specifications.
- Record Placement:** Gently place the record onto the turntable platter, aligning the center hole with the spindle.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (PLAYBACK)

- Starting Playback:** Power on your turntable and amplifier. Carefully lift the tonearm using the cueing lever and position the stylus just above the lead-in groove of the record. Lower the cueing lever slowly to allow the stylus to descend onto the record.
- Volume Adjustment:** Adjust the volume on your amplifier or receiver to a comfortable listening level.
- Stopping Playback:** At the end of a side, or when you wish to stop, use the cueing lever to gently lift the tonearm from the record. Return the tonearm to its rest and power off your equipment.

Note: Avoid manually dropping or dragging the stylus across the record surface, as this can cause damage to both the stylus and the record grooves.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care is crucial for maintaining the sound quality and extending the life of your vinyl record.

- Cleaning the Record:**
 - Before each play, gently wipe the record surface with a dedicated anti-static record brush to remove dust and loose particles.
 - For deeper cleaning, use a specialized record cleaning solution and a microfiber cloth, wiping in the direction of the grooves. Allow the record to dry completely before playing or storing.
- Storing the Record:**
 - Always store records vertically in their inner dust jackets and outer sleeves to prevent warping.
 - Keep records away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and areas with high humidity or extreme temperature fluctuations.
- Stylus Care:** Regularly inspect your turntable's stylus for dust and debris. Use a soft stylus brush or a specialized cleaning fluid if necessary, following the turntable manufacturer's instructions.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Skipping or Jumping	Dust/debris in grooves, incorrect tracking force, warped record, damaged stylus.	Clean record, check/adjust tracking force, inspect record for warps, check stylus condition.

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Excessive Static	Dry environment, friction during handling.	Use an anti-static brush, consider a humidifier, use anti-static inner sleeves.
Muffled or Distorted Sound	Dirty stylus, worn stylus, incorrect alignment, dirty record.	Clean stylus, replace worn stylus, verify cartridge alignment, clean record.
