IMC Audio Ai-net to 3.5mm Aux Input Cable User Manual

Model: Ai-net to 3.5mm Aux Input Cable

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the installation and operation of your IMC Audio Ai-net to 3.5mm Aux Input Cable. This cable allows you to connect external audio devices, such as smartphones or MP3 players, to compatible Alpine head units equipped with an Ai-net port, enabling audio playback through your car's sound system.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before beginning installation, ensure your vehicle's ignition is off and the car battery is disconnected to prevent electrical damage.

- Locate the Ai-net Port:** Identify the Ai-net port on the rear of your Alpine head unit. This port is typically a multi-pin connector. You may need to remove the head unit from its mounting to access the rear panel.
- Connect the Ai-net Cable:** Carefully plug the Ai-net connector of the IMC Audio cable into the corresponding Ai-net port on your Alpine head unit. Ensure a secure and firm connection.
- Route the 3.5mm Cable:** Route the 3.5mm auxiliary end of the cable to a convenient location within your vehicle, such as the glove compartment, center console, or dashboard, where your audio device will be placed. Ensure the cable is routed safely and does not interfere with vehicle operation.
- Reconnect Power:** Once the cable is securely connected and routed, reconnect your car battery and turn on the vehicle's ignition.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

After physical installation, you must enable the auxiliary input on your Alpine head unit.

1. **Power On Head Unit:** Turn on your Alpine head unit.
2. **Access Settings Menu:** Navigate to the head unit's settings or function menu. The exact steps vary by Alpine model, but typically involve pressing a 'Function', 'Setup', or 'Menu' button. Refer to your Alpine head unit's specific user manual for detailed navigation.
3. **Enable Auxiliary Input:** Within the settings menu, locate an option related to 'AUX Input', 'External Input', or 'CD Changer'. Ensure this option is set to 'On' or 'Enabled'. Some models may require you to select 'AUX' as a source.
4. **Select AUX Source:** Once enabled, repeatedly press the 'Source' or 'Mode' button on your Alpine head unit until 'AUX' or 'External' appears on the display.
5. **Connect Audio Device:** Plug your external audio device (e.g., smartphone, MP3 player) into the 3.5mm auxiliary jack of the IMC Audio cable.
6. **Play Audio:** Start playing audio on your connected device. Adjust the volume on both your device and the Alpine head unit for optimal sound.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Sound:**

- Ensure the Ai-net cable is securely connected to the head unit.
- Verify that the AUX input is enabled in your Alpine head unit's settings (refer to Operating Instructions).
- Confirm that the head unit's source is set to 'AUX'.
- Check the volume levels on both your external audio device and the Alpine head unit.
- Test with a different audio device or a different 3.5mm cable to rule out device or cable issues.

- **Intermittent Sound or Static:**

- Ensure all connections are firm and free from debris.
- Check for any kinks or damage to the cable.
- Ensure the 3.5mm jack is fully inserted into both the cable and your audio device.

- **Cable Does Not Fit:**

- Confirm your Alpine head unit model is compatible with an Ai-net input. This cable is designed for Alpine head units with an Ai-net port.
