1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides important information for the proper installation, use, and maintenance of your NISSAN Genuine Air Spoiler, model 96030-80F25. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation to ensure safe and correct operation. Keep this manual for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING:

- Always ensure the vehicle is parked on a level surface with the engine off and parking brake engaged before beginning any installation.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment, such as gloves and eye protection, during installation.
- Improper installation can lead to the spoiler detaching during vehicle operation, causing potential hazards. It is highly recommended that installation be performed by a qualified professional.
- Do not modify the spoiler or its mounting hardware. Use only genuine NISSAN parts for replacement.
- Keep small parts out of reach of children.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items listed below are present and undamaged before proceeding with installation. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact your NISSAN dealer or supplier.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Professional installation is strongly recommended for this product.

The following steps are general guidelines. Always refer to the specific service manual for your vehicle model for detailed instructions, torque specifications, and any special tools required.

1. **Preparation:** Clean the mounting surface on the vehicle thoroughly. Ensure it is free of dirt, wax, and grease. Allow the surface to dry completely.
2. **Positioning:** Carefully position the spoiler on the intended mounting area of the vehicle (typically the trunk lid). Ensure proper alignment before marking any drilling points.
3. **Marking and Drilling:** Using the spoiler as a template or referring to vehicle-specific instructions, mark the locations for drilling. Drill pilot holes as specified in your vehicle's service manual. Take extreme care to avoid damaging internal components or wiring.
4. **Gasket Application:** Apply the provided mounting gaskets to the underside of the spoiler where it will contact the vehicle surface. These gaskets help protect the paint and provide a seal.
5. **Mounting:** Secure the spoiler using the provided clips, fasteners, and nuts. Ensure all hardware is tightened to the manufacturer's specified torque values. Do not overtighten.
6. **Final Inspection:** After installation, gently attempt to move the spoiler to ensure it is securely fastened and does not wobble. Check for any gaps or misalignments.

5. OPERATION

The air spoiler is a passive aerodynamic component. Once correctly installed, it operates continuously to enhance vehicle stability and aesthetics. No user interaction is required for its operation.

Important:

- Ensure the spoiler remains securely attached at all times.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the spoiler or using it as a handle.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and integrity of your spoiler.

- **Cleaning:** Wash the spoiler regularly with mild automotive soap and water. Avoid abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or stiff brushes that could scratch the surface. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a soft cloth.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the spoiler for any signs of damage, cracks, or loose mounting hardware. If any issues are found, address them promptly. Tighten any loose fasteners to the specified torque.
- **Waxing:** Apply automotive wax to the spoiler's painted surface periodically to protect the finish and maintain its shine, similar to how you would wax the rest of your vehicle.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your spoiler, consider the following:

- **Spoiler is Loose/Wobbles:**
 - Check all mounting bolts and fasteners. Tighten them to the specified torque.
 - Inspect for any damaged mounting points or hardware. Replace if necessary with genuine NISSAN parts.
- **Unusual Noise from Spoiler:**
 - Ensure all mounting points are secure.
 - Check for any foreign objects trapped between the spoiler and the vehicle body.
 - Verify that gaskets are properly seated.
- **Damage to Spoiler Surface:**
 - For minor scratches, automotive touch-up paint may be used.
 - For significant damage (cracks, breaks), replacement of the spoiler may be necessary.

If problems persist, consult a qualified automotive technician or your NISSAN service center.
