# Gorenje W6202 Front-loading Washing Machine User Manual

Model: W6202 | Capacity: 6 kg

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Gorenje W6202 Front-loading Washing Machine. Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain them for future reference.

## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always adhere to the following safety guidelines to prevent injury or damage to the appliance.

- Ensure the washing machine is properly installed and grounded before use.
- Do not allow children to play with or operate the appliance.
- Never force the door open during operation.
- Unplug the appliance from the power supply before cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not wash items that have been cleaned in, washed in, soaked in, or spotted with combustible or explosive substances.
- This appliance is equipped with a Child Protection (CDP) feature. Refer to the 'Operating Instructions' section for activation details.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Gorenje W6202 is a 6 kg capacity front-loading washing machine designed for efficient and thorough laundry care. Key components include:

- **Control Panel:** Located on the top, featuring a program selector, temperature setting, and spin speed adjustment.
- **Detergent Dispenser:** For adding detergent and fabric softener.
- **Drum:** Stainless steel drum with a 180-degree opening door for easy loading.
- **Filter Access:** Located at the bottom front for easy maintenance.

## 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the performance and longevity of your washing machine. It is recommended to have the appliance installed by a qualified technician.

### 4.1 Unpacking

- Remove all packaging materials, including the transport bolts at the rear of the machine. Keep these bolts for future transport.
- Check for any damage during transit. If damaged, do not install and contact your retailer.

### 4.2 Positioning

- Place the machine on a firm, level surface.
- Adjust the leveling feet to ensure the machine is stable and does not wobble.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance.

### 4.3 Water and Electrical Connections

- Connect the water inlet hose to a cold water tap. Ensure connections are tight to prevent leaks.
- Position the drain hose correctly into a standpipe or sink, ensuring it is not kinked.
- Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps for optimal washing results.

### 5.1 Preparing Laundry

- Sort laundry by fabric type, color, and degree of soiling.
- Empty pockets and close zippers and fasteners.
- Load laundry loosely into the drum, ensuring not to exceed the 6 kg capacity.

### 5.2 Adding Detergent

- Add the appropriate amount of detergent to the main wash compartment of the dispenser.
- For pre-wash, add detergent to the pre-wash compartment.
- Add fabric softener to its designated compartment.

### 5.3 Selecting a Program

Turn the program selector knob to choose one of the available wash programs:

- **Standard Programs:** Cotton, Synthetic, Wool.
- **Special Programs:** UltraWhite, PerfectBlack, Cold wash, Rinse, Softening, Water pump, Spinning, Eco program.

### 5.4 Adjusting Settings

Customize your wash cycle using the following options:

- **Temperature Setting:** Adjust the wash temperature as needed.
- **Adjustable Spin Speed:** Select the desired spin speed up to 1000 RPM.
- **Pre-Wash:** Activate for heavily soiled items.
- **Personal Settings:** The machine allows for customized settings for all programs.

### 5.5 Starting and Stopping

- Press the Start/Pause button to begin the cycle.
- To pause a cycle, press the Start/Pause button again.
- To cancel a program, turn the program selector to the 'Off' position.

### 5.6 Child Protection (CDP)

To activate or deactivate the child lock, refer to the specific instructions in your machine's control panel guide. This feature prevents accidental changes to settings during operation.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficiency of your washing machine.

### 6.1 Cleaning the Detergent Dispenser

- Remove the dispenser drawer and rinse it under running water.
- Clean any residue from the compartments.

## 6.2 Cleaning the Drain Pump Filter

- Open the small cover at the bottom front of the machine.
- Place a shallow container to collect any residual water.
- Unscrew the filter slowly, allowing water to drain.
- Clean the filter of lint and foreign objects.
- Screw the filter back in securely and close the cover.

## 6.3 Cleaning the Exterior

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter. For more complex problems, contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Machine does not start	No power supply; Door not closed properly; Program not selected.	Check power plug and fuse; Ensure door is firmly closed; Select a wash program and press Start.
Water not filling	Water tap closed; Inlet hose kinked; Water supply pressure too low.	Open water tap; Straighten inlet hose; Check household water pressure.
Water not draining	Drain hose kinked or blocked; Drain pump filter clogged.	Check and clear drain hose; Clean the drain pump filter (refer to Maintenance).
Excessive vibration/noise	Transport bolts not removed; Machine not level; Uneven load.	Remove transport bolts; Adjust leveling feet; Redistribute laundry in the drum.
Service diagnostic indicator active	Internal error detected.	Note the error code (if displayed) and contact customer support.
