## 2. SETUP

The HT1075 offers versatile connectivity options to integrate with your existing devices. It includes two HDMI ports, one of which supports MHL for connecting compatible mobile devices. An optional wireless HDMI accessory is available for cable-free streaming.

The BenQ HT1075 is designed for intuitive operation, whether you're watching movies, playing games, or streaming content. The projector supports a wide screen size range from 40-inches up to 235-inches, depending on the throw distance.

### 3.1 Power On/Off and Source Selection

To power on the projector, press the power button on the unit or the remote control. Use the 'Source' button to cycle through available input connections (HDMI 1, HDMI 2/MHL, etc.) until your desired source is displayed.

### 3.2 3D Functionality

The BenQ HT1075 is 3D capable. To enjoy 3D content, you will need compatible 3D glasses (sold separately) and a 3D-enabled source device. Refer to your 3D glasses manual for pairing and usage instructions.

### 3.3 Audio

The projector features built-in speakers for convenient audio output. For a more immersive experience, connect external audio systems via the audio output ports.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your BenQ HT1075 projector.

### 4.1 Lamp Care

The projector lamp has a life of up to 3500 hours in normal mode and up to 5000 hours in economic mode. To maximize lamp life, ensure proper ventilation around the projector and allow it to cool down completely after use before unplugging or moving.

### 4.2 Cleaning

Regularly clean the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. For the lens, use a lens cleaning cloth and solution specifically designed for optical surfaces. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your BenQ HT1075 projector, refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **No Image:** Ensure all cables are securely connected and the correct input source is selected. Check if the lens cap is removed.
- **Overheating:** Ensure the projector's vents are not blocked and there is adequate airflow around the unit. Operating in a cool, well-ventilated area is crucial.
- **Fuzzy Image:** Adjust the focus ring on the lens until the image is sharp. Ensure the projector is within the recommended throw distance for your screen size.
- **Image Distortion:** Use the keystone correction and lens shift features to correct any trapezoidal or misaligned images.
- **No Audio:** Check the volume settings on both the projector and your source device. Ensure external audio systems are properly connected and selected.
