Cubicfun 3D Puzzle Santiago De Compostela Cathedral MC184H Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly and care of the Cubicfun 3D Puzzle Santiago De Compostela Cathedral, model MC184H. This 3D puzzle is designed to recreate the iconic Santiago De Compostela Cathedral using interlocking cardboard pieces. It is intended for users aged 14 years and older.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

5. **Connect Carefully:** Ensure each piece is correctly oriented and fully interlocked with its connecting parts. Incorrect alignment can lead to instability or damage.
6. **Review Progress:** Periodically check your assembly against the images in the instruction booklet to ensure accuracy.

3. USAGE AND DISPLAY

Once fully assembled, the Cubicfun Santiago De Compostela Cathedral 3D puzzle serves as a decorative

display model. Place it on a stable, flat surface where it can be admired without risk of falling or damage. Avoid placing it in high-traffic areas where it might be accidentally knocked over.

4. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your 3D puzzle model, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Dust the model gently with a soft, dry brush or cloth. Avoid using water, cleaning solutions, or abrasive materials, as these can damage the cardboard.
- **Storage Conditions:** Keep the assembled model away from direct sunlight, high humidity, and extreme temperature fluctuations. These conditions can cause the cardboard to warp, fade, or degrade.
- **Handling:** Always handle the model with care, supporting its base to prevent stress on the assembled parts.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Difficulty Interlocking Pieces:** Ensure you are using the correct pieces for the current step and that they are oriented correctly. Refer to the instruction diagrams closely. Do not force pieces together.
- **Missing or Damaged Pieces:** In the rare event of missing or damaged pieces, please contact CubicFun customer support with your product model number (MC184H) and details of the issue.
- **Model Instability:** Re-check all connections to ensure pieces are fully interlocked. Sometimes a piece may appear connected but is not fully seated.
