Kensington K97310ES KeyFolio Fit 10-inch Tablet Case with Keyboard User Manual

Model: KeyFolio Fit

INTRODUCTION

The Kensington KeyFolio Fit is an original product designed for both office and personal use, offering full performance for your tablet. This manual provides detailed instructions to help you set up, operate, maintain, and troubleshoot your KeyFolio Fit tablet case with an integrated Bluetooth keyboard.

1. SETUP

1.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the Kensington KeyFolio Fit from its packaging. Ensure all components are present: the tablet case with integrated keyboard.

1.2 Inserting Your Tablet

1. Open the KeyFolio Fit case.
2. Locate the flexible corner grips designed to secure your 10-inch tablet.
3. Gently slide your tablet into the case, ensuring each corner is securely held by the grips. The screen should face the keyboard when the case is open.

1.3 Pairing the Bluetooth Keyboard

1. Ensure the keyboard is charged (refer to Section 2.3 for charging instructions).
2. Turn on the keyboard. Look for a power switch or button, usually indicated by a power icon. An indicator light may illuminate.
3. Activate Bluetooth on your tablet. Go to your tablet's settings, find the Bluetooth option, and turn it on.
4. Put the keyboard into pairing mode. This usually involves pressing a dedicated Bluetooth pairing button or a combination of keys (e.g., Fn + C). The Bluetooth indicator light on the keyboard will typically flash to indicate pairing mode.
5. On your tablet, search for available Bluetooth devices. The keyboard should appear in the list, likely named "Kensington Keyboard" or similar.
6. Select the keyboard from the list on your tablet. You may be prompted to enter a pairing code displayed on your tablet's screen onto the keyboard, then press Enter.
7. Once paired, the keyboard's Bluetooth indicator light will stop flashing and remain solid, or turn off, depending on the model. Your tablet will confirm the connection.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Using the Integrated Stand

The KeyFolio Fit case features an integrated stand for comfortable viewing and typing. To activate the stand, simply fold the back cover of the case to prop up your tablet at an optimal angle. The design allows for stable positioning on flat surfaces.

2.2 Typing with the Keyboard

Once paired, the Bluetooth keyboard functions like a standard computer keyboard. It features a Spanish (QWERTY) layout. You can use it for typing documents, emails, navigating your tablet, and more. Familiarize

yourself with the function keys (Fn) which may provide shortcuts for media control, volume, and other tablet functions when pressed in combination with other keys.

2.3 Charging the Keyboard

The integrated keyboard is powered by a rechargeable lithium-ion battery. When the battery is low, connect the keyboard to a power source using the appropriate charging cable (e.g., Micro-USB or USB-C, typically not included with the case). A charging indicator light will usually show the charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged.

2.4 Closing the Case

When not in use, fold the case closed to protect your tablet and keyboard. The case is designed to securely enclose your device, offering scratch resistance and general protection.

3. MAINTENANCE

3.1 Cleaning

- **Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the case with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Keyboard:** Use a soft, dry cloth or a can of compressed air to remove dust and debris from between the keys. For stubborn marks, lightly dampen a cloth with water or a mild electronic cleaner and gently wipe the keycaps. Ensure no liquid enters the keyboard mechanism.
- **Tablet Grips:** Periodically check the flexible grips for any wear or damage. Clean them gently with a damp cloth if needed.

3.2 Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the KeyFolio Fit in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure the case is closed to protect both the tablet and the keyboard.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

4.1 Keyboard Not Connecting/Pairing

- **Check Power:** Ensure the keyboard is turned on and has sufficient battery charge.
- **Re-pair:** Delete the keyboard from your tablet's Bluetooth device list and attempt the pairing process again (refer to Section 1.3).
- **Tablet Bluetooth:** Ensure your tablet's Bluetooth is enabled and discoverable.
- **Distance:** Make sure the keyboard is within the effective range of your tablet (typically 10 meters or 33 feet).
- **Interference:** Move away from other wireless devices that might cause interference.

4.2 Keys Not Responding

- **Battery:** The keyboard battery might be low. Charge the keyboard.
- **Connection:** The Bluetooth connection might have dropped. Reconnect or re-pair the keyboard.
- **Cleanliness:** Check for debris under the keys. Refer to cleaning instructions in Section 3.1.

4.3 Power Issues

- **Keyboard Not Turning On:** Ensure the keyboard is fully charged. If it still doesn't turn on, the battery might be faulty or depleted beyond recovery.
- **Charging Indicator:** If the charging indicator light does not illuminate when plugged in, try a different charging cable or power source.
