INTRODUCTION

SETUP

Proper preparation is key to an enjoyable puzzle-building experience, especially with a 6000-piece puzzle.

- 1. Unpack the Box:** Carefully open the puzzle box and remove all contents. The box contains the unassembled puzzle pieces.
- 2. Prepare Your Workspace:** Ensure you have a large, flat, and stable surface. The completed puzzle measures approximately 53.54 inches (136 cm) by 37.8 inches (96 cm), so allocate sufficient space. Good lighting is essential to distinguish colors and details.
- 3. Initial Sorting:** Begin by separating all the edge pieces from the interior pieces. Edge pieces typically have one flat side.
- 4. Organize Pieces:** For a puzzle of this size, it is highly recommended to sort the remaining pieces by color, pattern, or distinct features. Using multiple sorting trays or containers can be very helpful.

OPERATING (ASSEMBLY)

Follow these steps to assemble your jigsaw puzzle:

1. **Build the Frame:** Start by assembling the border of the puzzle using the edge pieces you sorted earlier. This provides a clear boundary and helps define the overall shape.
2. **Work on Distinct Areas:** Refer to the image on the puzzle box. Identify distinct areas of color or pattern (e.g., the Eiffel Tower, buildings, sky, street). Work on these sections independently.
3. **Connect Sections:** Once smaller sections are completed, begin connecting them to each other and to the main border.
4. **Patience and Persistence:** Large puzzles require significant time and patience. Take breaks when needed and approach challenging areas from different angles.

- **Difficulty:** If you find the puzzle challenging, try sorting the pieces again into smaller, more manageable groups. Take frequent breaks to rest your eyes and mind. Sometimes, looking at the puzzle from a different perspective can help.
- **Pieces Don't Fit:** Ensure you are attempting to connect pieces with the correct shape and image alignment. Some pieces may appear similar; double-check the image on the box.
