## INTRODUCTION

### 2. Wrong Sound Playing:

- Review per-app notification settings to confirm the correct sound is selected.
- If using custom sounds, ensure the audio file is still present and accessible on the device.

### 3. Intermittent Sounds:

- Restart your device.
- Clear the cache for the problematic app (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage > Clear Cache).

### 4. Sound Too Low/High:

- Adjust the notification volume slider in your device's sound settings.
- Some apps have their own internal volume controls; check these if applicable.
