# Cuisinart BFP-650 1 HP Blender/Food Processor Instruction Manual

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Cuisinart BFP-650 is a versatile 1 HP Blender/Food Processor designed for various kitchen tasks. This 3-in-1 appliance combines the functionality of a powerful blender, a convenient food processor, and portable travel cups, offering efficiency and ease of use for your daily culinary needs.

## COMPONENTS AND FEATURES

Your Cuisinart BFP-650 comes with several key components designed for optimal performance and convenience:

- **Main Base:** Houses the powerful 1-horsepower motor and electronic touchpad controls.
- **Blender Jar:** A 56-ounce BPA-free Tritan plastic jar with integrated ultra-sharp stainless steel blades. It features clear measurement markings in cups and ounces/milliliters, and an ergonomic soft-grip handle for easy lifting and pouring.
- **Blender Lid:** A tight-seal lid with a removable 2-ounce measuring cap, allowing for easy addition of ingredients during operation.
- **Food Processor Attachment:** A 3-cup capacity attachment including a feed tube, pusher, slicer/shredder disc, and a stainless steel chopper blade.
- **Travel Cups:** Two 16-ounce travel cups for on-the-go convenience.
- **Control Panel:** Electronic touchpad with LED indicators, featuring Low, High, and Pulse controls, as well as pre-programmed Smoothie and Ice Crush functions.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, wash all removable parts in warm, soapy water. Ensure the unit is unplugged before assembly.

### Assembling the Blender

1. Place the main base on a clean, dry, and stable surface.
2. Align the blender jar with the base and twist clockwise until it locks securely into place.
3. Place the lid onto the blender jar and twist to ensure a tight seal. Insert the 2-ounce measuring cap into the lid opening.

### Assembling the Food Processor

1. Remove the blender jar from the base.
2. Place the food processor attachment onto the base, aligning it correctly.
3. Insert the desired blade (chopping blade or reversible slicing/shredding disc) onto the center stem of the food processor bowl. For the slicing/shredding disc, ensure the desired side (shred or slice) is facing up.

4. Place the food processor lid onto the bowl and twist to lock. Insert the pusher into the feed tube.

## Assembling the Travel Cups

1. Fill the 16-ounce travel cup with your desired ingredients.
2. Remove the blade assembly from the main blender jar (if attached).
3. Screw the blade assembly onto the open end of the travel cup, ensuring it is tightly sealed.
4. Invert the travel cup and align the tabs on the blade assembly with the slots on the main base. Push down and twist to lock it into place.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Cuisinart BFP-650 features an intuitive electronic touchpad for easy operation.

### Basic Operation

- Plug the unit into a power outlet. The On/Off button will blink, indicating standby mode.
- Press the **On/Off** button to activate the unit.
- Select your desired speed: **Low**, **High**, or **Pulse**. The Pulse function provides short bursts of power for controlled processing.
- For pre-programmed cycles, press the **Smoothie** or **Ice Crush** buttons. These cycles will run automatically and stop when complete.
- To add ingredients during operation, remove the 2-ounce measuring cap from the blender lid or use the feed

tube on the food processor.

## Using the Food Processor

- The **chopping blade** is ideal for nuts, herbs, onions, and small batches of food, including baby food.
- The **reversible slicing/shredding disc** allows you to either slice or shred ingredients depending on which side is facing up. Always hold the disc by its hub when handling.
- When slicing or shredding, use the pusher to guide ingredients through the feed tube with even pressure for best results.

## Using the Travel Cups

- After blending in the travel cup, carefully remove the cup with the blade assembly from the base.
- Unscrew the blade assembly from the travel cup.
- Screw on the travel lid to seal the cup for portability. The travel lid features a large opening and a well to prevent spills.

## USAGE EXAMPLE: SUPER ANTIOXIDANT SMOOTHIE

This recipe demonstrates the versatility of your Cuisinart BFP-650.

### Ingredients:

- Pomegranate juice
- Frozen berries (e.g., raspberries, blueberries, blackberries)
- Banana
- Flax seed

### Instructions (using main blender jar):

1. Add pomegranate juice to the blender jar.
2. Add frozen berries, banana, and flax seed. Using frozen fruit helps keep the smoothie cold without diluting it with ice.
3. Secure the lid.
4. Press the **Smoothie** pre-programmed function. Allow the cycle to complete for a perfectly smooth consistency.

### Instructions (using travel cup):

1. Add pomegranate juice, frozen berries, banana, and flax seed directly into the travel cup.
2. Screw the blade assembly onto the travel cup.
3. Invert the travel cup and align the tabs on the blade assembly with the slots on the main base. Push down and twist to lock it into place.
4. Press the **Smoothie** pre-programmed function.
5. Once blended, remove the travel cup, unscrew the blade assembly, and attach the travel lid.

## MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper care ensures the longevity of your Cuisinart BFP-650.

- All removable parts, including the blender jar, food processor bowl, lids, blades, and travel cups, are **dishwasher safe**.
- For manual cleaning, **hand wash** all components with warm, soapy water.
- Wipe the main base with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the base in water.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before storing.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

For detailed troubleshooting steps and common issues, please refer to the official user manual.

A common tip for blending is to ensure sufficient liquid is added to allow ingredients to circulate properly. If the unit stops unexpectedly, check that all attachments are securely locked into place on the base.
