1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use and care of your Casio AE-1200WHD-1A digital watch. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece. The Casio AE-1200WHD-1A features multiple functions including World Time, Stopwatch, Timer, and Alarms, all powered by a 10-year battery.





2. INITIAL SETUP

2.1. Button Functions

Your watch has four buttons: **A** (Adjust), **B** (Mode), **C** (Search), and **D** (Light). Refer to the diagram below for their locations.

2.2. Setting the Time and Date

- 1. In the Timekeeping Mode, hold down the A (Adjust) button until the city code starts to flash. This indicates the setting mode.
- 2. Press the **C** (Search) button to cycle through the settings: City Code → DST (Daylight Saving Time) → 12/24-hour format → Seconds → Hour → Minute → Year → Month → Day.
- 3. Use the **B** (Mode) button to increase the flashing value or the **D** (Light) button to decrease it. For city code, use **B** and **D** to select your desired city.
- 4. Once all settings are correct, press the A (Adjust) button to exit the setting mode.

2.3. Adjusting the Bracelet

The stainless steel bracelet can be adjusted for a comfortable fit. This typically involves removing or adding links. It is recommended to have this procedure performed by a qualified jeweler to prevent damage to the watch or bracelet. If adjusting yourself, use appropriate tools to carefully open the clasp and remove pins from links as needed.

3. OPERATING MODES

Press the **B** (Mode) button to cycle through the different modes: Timekeeping \rightarrow World Time \rightarrow Stopwatch \rightarrow Timer \rightarrow Alarm.

3.1. Timekeeping Mode

This is the default mode, displaying the current time, date, and day of the week. The small analog-style dial shows seconds, and the world map indicates the current time zone.

3.2. World Time Mode

In World Time Mode, you can view the current time in 48 cities (31 time zones) around the globe. Press the **C** (Search) button to scroll through the city codes. The world map display will highlight the selected time zone.

3.3. Stopwatch Mode

The stopwatch measures elapsed time, split times, and two finishes.

- Press C (Search) to start/stop the stopwatch.
- While the stopwatch is running, press **A** (Adjust) to record a split time. Press **A** again to release the split and continue timing.
- When the stopwatch is stopped, press A (Adjust) to reset it to zero.

3.4. Timer Mode

The countdown timer can be set for up to 24 hours.

- In Timer Mode, hold down A (Adjust) to enter setting mode. The hour value will flash.
- Use B (Mode) to increase the value and D (Light) to decrease it. PressC (Search) to move between hours and minutes.
- Press A (Adjust) to exit setting mode.
- Press C (Search) to start or stop the countdown.

3.5. Alarm Mode

The watch features 5 independent daily alarms and an hourly time signal.

- In Alarm Mode, press C (Search) to cycle through the alarms (AL1, AL2, AL3, AL4, AL5, SIG).
- Hold down A (Adjust) to enter setting mode for the selected alarm. The hour value will flash.
- Use **B** (Mode) to increase and **D** (Light) to decrease the hour/minute. Press**C** (Search) to switch between hour and minute settings.
- Press A (Adjust) to exit setting mode.
- Press **D** (Light) to toggle the selected alarm ON/OFF. The alarm indicator will appear when an alarm is active.

3.6. Illuminator (Backlight)

Press the **D** (Light) button in any mode (except when setting) to illuminate the display for easy viewing in low light conditions.

3.7. Water Resistance

The Casio AE-1200WHD-1A is water resistant up to 100 meters (10 BAR). This means it is suitable for swimming, showering, and snorkeling. However, it is not recommended for scuba diving. **Do not operate the buttons while the watch is wet or submerged.**

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1. Battery Replacement

This watch is equipped with a 10-year battery (CR2025). When the display becomes dim or functions become erratic, it may be time for battery replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by an authorized service center to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.

4.2. Cleaning

Wipe the watch and band with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and moisture. For stainless steel bands, a mild soap solution and a soft brush can be used, followed by thorough rinsing and drying. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.

4.3. Water Resistance Precautions

- Avoid operating buttons while the watch is submerged or wet.
- Do not expose the watch to extreme temperature changes (e.g., hot shower immediately followed by cold water).
- If the watch is exposed to saltwater, rinse it thoroughly with fresh water and dry it with a soft cloth.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Display is blank or dim:** The battery may be low. Replace the battery as described in the Maintenance section.
- **Time is incorrect:** Re-set the time and date using the instructions in the Initial Setup section. Ensure the correct city code and DST setting are selected.
- **Buttons are unresponsive:** Ensure the watch is not in a setting mode that locks out other buttons. If the issue persists, a battery reset or professional inspection may be required.
- Water inside the watch: Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center. Do not attempt to open the watch yourself, as this will void the warranty and can cause further damage.
