# Lenovo A536 Smartphone User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your Lenovo A536 smartphone. Please read it thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

### 1.1 Package Contents

## 2. SETUP

---

Follow these steps to prepare your Lenovo A536 for first-time use.

### 2.1 Inserting the SIM Card(s) and Battery

1. Power off the device if it is on.
2. Carefully remove the back cover of the phone.
3. Insert the SIM card(s) into the designated slot(s) with the gold contacts facing down. The Lenovo A536 supports dual SIM functionality.
4. Insert the battery into its compartment, ensuring the contacts align correctly.
5. Replace the back cover until it clicks securely into place.

## 2.2 Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the battery using the provided charger. Connect the charger to the phone's

- To power on: Press and hold the Power button until the Lenovo logo appears.
- To power off: Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Power off' from the options.

## 3. OPERATING YOUR DEVICE

Familiarize yourself with the basic functions and features of your Lenovo A536.

### 3.1 Android 4.4.2 KitKat Operating System

Your Lenovo A536 runs on Android 4.4.2 KitKat, offering a responsive and intuitive user experience. Navigate through apps, widgets, and settings using the touchscreen interface.

### 3.2 Basic Navigation

- **Touchscreen:** Tap to select, swipe to scroll, pinch to zoom.

- **GPS:** Utilize satellite-controlled GPS for navigation, even offline with pre-downloaded maps.

### 3.5 Preloaded Applications

- **SHAREit:** Share files wirelessly with other devices without network charges or a Wi-Fi connection.
- **Security:** Optimize phone performance and protect against viruses.
- **SYNCit:** Back up and restore contacts, SMS messages, and call logs.

## 4. MAINTENANCE

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

### 5.1 Device Not Powering On

### 5.2 Poor Network Signal or No Service

- Check if the SIM card is correctly inserted.
- Ensure you are in an area with network coverage.

- Verify that Airplane mode is not enabled.

### 5.3 Applications Crashing or Freezing

- Close and reopen the application.
- Clear the app's cache and data (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage).
- Ensure your device has sufficient free storage space.
- Update the application to its latest version.

### 5.4 Touchscreen Unresponsive

- Restart the device.
- Ensure the screen is clean and free from moisture or debris.
- Remove any screen protectors that might be interfering with touch sensitivity.
