### INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Genius SW-2.1 355 Speaker System. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your listening experience.

### SAFETY INFORMATION

- Avoid placing the speakers near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the subwoofer to prevent overheating.
- Use only the power adapter supplied with the unit.
- Do not attempt to open or repair the unit yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- · Keep out of reach of children.

# **PRODUCT OVERVIEW**

The Genius SW-2.1 355 Speaker System consists of a subwoofer and two satellite speakers designed to

deliver clear audio and powerful bass for your multimedia needs.

## **Components:**

- Subwoofer: The main unit housing the bass driver and control panel.

# **SETUP**

- 1. **Positioning Speakers:** Place the subwoofer on the floor or a sturdy surface. Position the satellite speakers on either side of your listening area, facing towards you for optimal stereo separation.
- 2. **Connecting Satellite Speakers:** Connect the cables from the two satellite speakers to the corresponding output jacks on the rear of the subwoofer unit. Ensure a secure connection.
- 3. **Connecting Audio Source:** Connect one end of the 3.5mm audio input cable to the "Audio In" jack on the subwoofer. Connect the other end to the audio output jack (e.g., headphone jack) of your computer, MP3 player, smartphone, or other audio source.
- 4. **Connecting Power:** Plug the power adapter into the DC input jack on the subwoofer. Then, plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
- 5. **Power On:** Turn on the speaker system using the power switch, usually integrated with the volume knob.

### **OPERATION**

- Power On/Off and Volume Control: The main knob on the subwoofer controls both power and overall volume. Rotate clockwise to turn on and increase volume; rotate counter-clockwise to decrease volume and turn off.
- Bass Adjustment: Use the "Bass" knob on the subwoofer to adjust the level of low-frequency sound.

Rotate clockwise to increase bass, and counter-clockwise to decrease it, according to your preference.

• Audio Source Volume: For optimal sound quality, set the volume on your audio source (computer, phone, etc.) to about 75% and then use the speaker system's volume control for fine adjustments.

### MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surfaces of the speakers. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** If storing the speakers for an extended period, disconnect them from power and store them in a cool, dry place.
- Cable Management: Ensure cables are not tangled or pinched to prevent damage.

# **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound	Power not connected or off.  Volume too low.  Audio cable disconnected.  Audio source not playing or volume too low.	Ensure power adapter is plugged in and power switch is on. Increase the volume on the speaker system and audio source. Check all audio cable connections. Verify audio is playing from the source device.
Distorted sound	Volume too high on speakers or source.  Poor audio cable connection.  Interference.	Reduce volume on both the speaker system and audio source.  Ensure audio cable is securely connected.  Move speakers away from other electronic devices.
Weak bass	Bass knob set too low. Subwoofer placement.	Increase the "Bass" knob on the subwoofer.  Experiment with subwoofer placement for better bass response.


