## **SETUP**

# 1. Charging the Device and Modules

- 1. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging dock and then to the power adapter. Plug the adapter into a wall outlet.
- 2. Place the Compex SP 8.0 stimulator unit into the designated slot on the charging dock.
- 3. Place the four wireless modules (pods) into their respective slots on the charging dock.
- 4. Allow the device and modules to charge fully before first use. The charging indicator lights will change when charging is complete.

#### 2. Attaching Electrodes to Modules

- 1. Ensure your skin is clean and dry before applying electrodes.
- 2. Snap the electrodes onto the wireless modules. Each module typically connects to two electrodes.
- 3. Peel the protective film from the electrodes and apply them firmly to the desired muscle area. Refer to the device's on-screen guidance for correct electrode placement for specific programs.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

# 1. Powering On and Program Selection

- 1. Press and hold the power button on the stimulator unit to turn it on.
- 2. Navigate through the menu using the directional buttons to select your desired program (e.g., Endurance, Strength, Pain Relief, Recovery). The device will display recommended electrode placements for each program.
- 3. Confirm your selection to start the program.




Image: A user holding the Compex SP 8.0 stimulator unit, with wireless modules and electrodes attached to their legs, demonstrating in-use operation.

#### 2. Adjusting Intensity

During a program, use the intensity buttons to increase or decrease the stimulation level for each channel. Adjust the intensity until you feel a strong, comfortable muscle contraction. Avoid discomfort or pain.

## 3. Muscle Intelligence (MI) Technology

- **MI-SCAN:** This feature scans the muscle and automatically adjusts the stimulator parameters to your unique physiology, ensuring personalized and effective stimulation.
- **MI-ACTION:** Optimizes session effectiveness by combining voluntary muscle contractions with electrostimulated contractions, providing greater control over your workout.
- **MI-TENS:** Facilitates easier adjustment of stimulation levels for anti-pain programs, helping to ensure optimal pain relief results.
- **MI-AUTORANGE:** Automatically determines the most appropriate level of stimulation, ensuring you receive the optimum performance without manual adjustment.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

#### **Cleaning the Device**

Wipe the stimulator unit and modules with a soft, damp cloth after each use. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the device in water.

#### **Electrode Care and Storage**

- After each session, carefully remove the electrodes from your skin and reattach them to their protective film.
- Store electrodes in a cool, dry place, preferably in their original sealed bag or the device's carry case.
- Replace electrodes when they lose their adhesiveness or if they cause discomfort during use.

#### **Battery Care**

To prolong battery life, fully charge the device and modules regularly, even if not in frequent use. Avoid completely draining the batteries before recharging.
