Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Steba BS-1800 Quick Heater. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your new appliance. Please read all instructions carefully before installation and use, and retain this manual for future reference.

The Steba BS-1800 is an energy-saving quick heater designed for bathroom use, featuring a programmable timer, motion sensor, and touch controls for enhanced comfort and efficiency.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always observe basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- · Read all instructions before using this heater.
- This heater is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces.
- Extreme caution is necessary when any heater is used by or near children or invalids and whenever the heater is left operating and unattended.
- Do not operate any heater with a damaged cord or plug or after the heater malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- Do not use outdoors. This heater is intended for indoor, bathroom use only.
- To disconnect heater, turn controls to off, then remove plug from outlet.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the heater.
- To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner.
- This heater has hot and arcing or sparking parts inside. Do not use it in areas where gasoline, paint, or flammable liquids are used or stored.
- Use this heater only as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- This appliance is splash-proof (IP24 rated) and suitable for bathroom installation, but must not be installed directly above a bath or shower.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Steba BS-1800 Quick Heater is designed for wall-mounted installation. Ensure the mounting location is suitable and adheres to local electrical and safety regulations.

Mounting Location

- Choose a wall location that is clear of obstructions and allows for proper air circulation.
- Ensure the wall material can support the weight of the heater (approximately 4.84 pounds).
- Maintain a safe distance from water sources, as per IP24 rating guidelines for bathroom appliances.

Installation Steps

- 1. Carefully unpack the heater and all accessories. Inspect for any damage.
- 2. Using the provided mounting template (if included) or by measuring the heater's dimensions, mark the drilling points on the wall. Refer to the dimensions diagram below.
- 3. Drill holes and insert appropriate wall plugs (not always included, depending on wall type).
- 4. Secure the mounting bracket to the wall.
- 5. Carefully hang the heater onto the mounting bracket, ensuring it is securely seated.
- 6. Connect the power plug to a suitable electrical outlet. Ensure the outlet is properly grounded and rated for the heater's power requirements.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Steba BS-1800 features intuitive touch controls and various modes for optimal heating.

Control Panel Overview

Basic Operation

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficient operation of your Steba BS-1800 Quick Heater.

Cleaning

- Always unplug the heater and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure no water enters the internal components.

Filter Maintenance

The heater may contain a washable, removable filter. Regularly check and clean the filter to maintain optimal airflow and heating efficiency.

- Locate the filter access point (typically on the side or rear of the unit).
- Remove the filter and gently clean it with a soft brush or rinse under lukewarm water.
- Allow the filter to dry completely before reinserting it into the heater.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Steba BS-1800 Quick Heater, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Heater does not turn on.	No power supply; power button not pressed; overheating protection activated.	Check power outlet and plug connection. Press power button. Allow unit to cool down if overheating protection was triggered.
Heater produces insufficient heat.	Temperature setting too low; air intake/exhaust blocked; dirty filter.	Increase temperature setting. Ensure clear airflow around the unit. Clean the air filter.
Motion sensor not responding.	Sensor obstructed; incorrect mode selected.	Ensure sensor is clear of obstructions. Verify the heater is in a mode that utilizes the motion sensor.
Unusual noises or odors.	Dust accumulation; internal component issue.	Unplug immediately. Clean the unit. If problem persists, discontinue use and contact customer support.
