## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This cable features a USB-A Male connector on one end and a Mini-B Male connector on the other. Both connectors are gold-plated for optimal signal clarity and to minimize interference, ensuring reliable performance.




Figure 1: Close-up view of the USB-A Male and Mini-B Male connectors, highlighting the gold-plated contacts.




Figure 5: A comprehensive chart detailing various USB connector types for identification.

## SETUP

To set up your Amazon Basics USB-A to Mini USB 2.0 Cable:

1. Identify the USB-A port on your computer or charging adapter. This is typically a rectangular port.
2. Identify the Mini-B port on your device (e.g., digital camera, external hard drive, gaming controller). This port is smaller and trapezoidal.
3. Insert the USB-A Male end of the cable into the USB-A port on your computer or adapter.
4. Insert the Mini-B Male end of the cable into the Mini-B port on your device.
5. Ensure both connections are secure.




Figure 6: Example of the cable connecting a digital camera to a laptop.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once connected, the cable will enable the following functions:

### Data Transfer:

- The cable supports USB 2.0 standards, allowing for data transfer speeds of up to 480 Megabits Per Second.
- This is suitable for transferring photos, videos, and other files between your computer and compatible devices.
- The cable is backwards compatible with USB 1.0 devices.

### Charging:

- Use the cable to charge devices that draw power via a Mini-B USB port, such as certain smartphones, GPS devices, or portable speakers.
- Ensure your power source (computer USB port or wall adapter) provides adequate power for your device. The cable supports up to 5 Volts.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your cable:

- Avoid bending the cable sharply or crimping it, as this can damage the internal wires.
- Store the cable in a clean, dry place away from extreme temperatures.
- Gently pull on the connector housing, not the cable itself, when disconnecting from devices.
- Keep connectors free from dust and debris to maintain good contact.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your cable, try the following:

- **Device Not Recognized:** Ensure both ends of the cable are securely plugged into their respective ports. Try connecting to a different USB port on your computer or a different device to rule out port or device issues.
- **Slow Data Transfer:** Verify that both your computer and device support USB 2.0 speeds. Older USB 1.0 ports will operate at slower speeds.
- **Not Charging:** Confirm that the power source (e.g., USB wall adapter) is functional and provides sufficient power for your device. Try a different charging cable or adapter if available.
- **Intermittent Connection:** Check for any visible damage to the cable or connectors. Ensure connectors are clean and free of debris.
