Zeppelin Graf Hindenburg Moonphase Watch User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Zeppelin Graf Hindenburg Swiss Quartz Moonphase Calendar Dress Analogue Watch, model 7036-1. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and longevity of your timepiece.

SETUP

Initial Time and Date Setting

Your Zeppelin Graf Hindenburg watch features a precise Swiss Quartz movement with moon phase and calendar functions. To set the time and date:

1. **Pull out the crown:** Gently pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) to position 2 (the outermost position).
2. **Set the time:** Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands to the correct time. Ensure you differentiate between AM and PM for accurate date change.
3. **Push the crown back:** Once the time is set, push the crown back to position 0 (normal operating position).

Setting Calendar and Moon Phase

The watch features subdials for day of the week, date, and moon phase. Specific setting instructions for these functions are typically found in the detailed movement manual. For the 7036-1 model, these are often adjusted via small pushers on the side of the watch case, or by pulling the crown to an intermediate position (position 1) and rotating it. Refer to the manufacturer's website for a detailed movement guide if needed.

Note: Avoid setting the date or moon phase between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement's gears during the automatic date change cycle.

OPERATING THE WATCH

Reading the Dials

- **Main Dial:** Displays hours, minutes, and seconds.
- **Day Subdial:** Indicates the current day of the week (e.g., MON, TUE).

- **Date Subdial:** Shows the current day of the month.
- **Moon Phase Indicator:** Displays the current phase of the moon. This typically cycles over approximately 29.5 days.

Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant. While it can withstand splashes or brief immersion, it is not suitable for swimming, diving, or prolonged water exposure. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in to maintain water resistance.

Cleaning

To maintain the appearance of your watch, clean it regularly with a soft, dry cotton cloth. For the leather strap, avoid excessive moisture and harsh chemicals. If the watch becomes wet, dry it immediately with a soft cloth.

Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a LR44 battery. When the watch stops or the second hand begins to jump in irregular intervals (low battery indicator), it is time for a battery replacement. It is highly recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watchmaker to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

- **Watch has stopped:** Check if the crown is fully pushed in. If it is, the battery may need replacement.
- **Date/Day/Moon Phase not advancing:** Ensure the time is set correctly, especially AM/PM. Avoid setting these functions during the automatic change period (9 PM - 3 AM). If issues persist, consult a professional watchmaker.
- **Condensation under crystal:** This indicates a loss of water resistance. Immediately take the watch to a qualified watchmaker to prevent further damage to the movement.
