#### Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the Magnasonic Digital AM/FM Clock Radio, Model EAAC201. It covers setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device. This clock radio features a digital AM/FM tuner with station memory, dual alarms, battery backup, and adjustable display brightness.

## **S**ETUP

#### **Power Connection**

To power the clock radio, plug the AC cord into a standard wall outlet. Upon initial power-up, the display will typically flash "12:00" indicating it is ready for time setting.

## **Battery Backup Installation**

For reliable time and alarm settings during power outages, install two AA 1.5V batteries (not included) into the battery compartment located on the bottom of the unit. Ensure correct polarity.

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Setting the Time**

- 1. Plug the clock into a wall outlet. The time display will flash.
- 2. Press the **HR** (Hour) and **MIN** (Minute) buttons to adjust the clock to the current time. Hold the buttons down for faster adjustment.
- 3. A small dot will appear next to "PM" on the display after reaching 12 PM.
- 4. Press the **SET TIME** button to save your changes and set the time.
- 5. To change the time after initial setup, press and hold the **SET TIME** button until the display flashes, then repeat the previous steps.

## **Setting the Alarm (Dual Alarms)**

The clock radio features two independent alarms (Alarm 1 and Alarm 2).

- 1. Ensure the radio is off. If it is on, press the AM/FM button to turn it off.
- 2. Press and hold your selected alarm button (ALARM 1 or ALARM 2) for two seconds. The alarm time will start flashing.
- 3. Use the HR (Hour) and MIN (Minute) buttons to change the alarm time.
- 4. Press the alarm button again to cycle through alarm options:
  - Buzzer: A bell icon will appear on the display.
  - Radio: A music note icon will appear on the display.
  - Off: No icon will appear.
- 5. Press the **SET TIME** button or wait 10 seconds for the settings to save automatically.

Note: Alarm volume cannot be adjusted independently; it uses the last set radio volume.

#### **Snooze and Sleep Functions**

- Snooze: When the alarm sounds, press the large SNOOZE/SLEEP/DIM button to temporarily silence the alarm for 9 minutes. The alarm will reactivate after this period.
- Sleep: To set a sleep timer for the radio, press the SNOOZE/SLEEP/DIM button repeatedly while the radio is playing to cycle through sleep timer options (e.g., 90, 60, 30, 15 minutes, or OFF). The radio will automatically turn off after the selected time.
- Dimmer: Press the SNOOZE/SLEEP/DIM button when the alarm is not active to adjust the display brightness between high and low settings.

#### Radio Operation (AM/FM)

- Press the AM/FM button to turn the radio on or off and to switch between AM and FM bands.
- Use the **HR** (Hour) and **MIN** (Minute) buttons to tune the radio frequency.
- Setting Presets: The unit can store up to 20 programmable stations.
  - a. Tune to the desired station.
  - b. Press and hold the **SET TIME** button until the display flashes.
  - c. Use the ALARM 1 or ALARM 2 buttons to select a preset number (1-20).
  - d. Press **SET TIME** again to save the station to the selected preset.
- Recalling Presets: Briefly press the SET TIME button to cycle through saved preset stations.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

To ensure the longevity and proper functioning of your Magnasonic clock radio, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit. Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they may damage the finish.
- Battery Replacement: Replace the backup batteries annually or when the display shows signs of dimming or erratic behavior during power interruptions.
- **Placement:** Place the unit on a stable, flat surface away from direct sunlight, heat sources, and excessive moisture. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.

Noise or sound distorted on AM or FM.	AM: Interference. FM: Antenna wire not extended.	Position the radio for better AM reception. Extend antenna wire.	
CLOCK			
Incorrect time.	Clock not set.  Batteries inserted incorrectly, not connected or depleted.	Set the clock. Check batteries.	
Alarm does not turn on.	Alarm is not set to turn on. Clock is not set. Alarm time is not set.	Press and hold the ALARM 1 or ALARM 2 button to turn the alarm on. Set the clock. Set alarm time.
