## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and maintenance of your Breville .BES820XL/205.1 One Cup Dual Wall Filter. This filter is an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) authorized part designed to ensure optimal performance with compatible Breville espresso machines. Please read these instructions carefully before use.

## COMPATIBILITY

---

The Breville .BES820XL/205.1 One Cup Dual Wall Filter is designed to fit various Breville espresso machine models. It is crucial to verify your machine's portafilter size and compatibility requirements before use. This filter is 50mm in diameter.

## SETUP AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

1. **Preparation:** Ensure your espresso machine is clean and powered on.
2. **Insert Filter:** Place the Breville One Cup Dual Wall Filter securely into the portafilter of your espresso machine. Ensure it sits flush and is properly seated.
3. **Add Coffee:** Grind fresh coffee beans to an appropriate espresso fineness or use pre-ground espresso

coffee. For a single shot, typically 7-10 grams of coffee are used. Distribute the coffee evenly in the filter basket.

4. **Tamp:** Use a tamper to apply firm, even pressure to the coffee grounds. This creates a compact puck, essential for proper extraction.
5. **Attach Portafilter:** Securely attach the portafilter to the group head of your espresso machine.
6. **Brew:** Initiate the brewing cycle according to your espresso machine's instructions. The dual wall design helps regulate pressure for a consistent extraction.
7. **Remove and Clean:** After brewing, carefully remove the portafilter. Discard the used coffee grounds (puck) and rinse the filter immediately.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular cleaning of your filter is essential for optimal performance and longevity.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, remove the filter from the portafilter and rinse it thoroughly under hot water to remove all coffee residue. Use a brush if necessary to clear any clogged holes.
- **Deep Cleaning:** Periodically, soak the filter in a solution of espresso machine cleaner (e.g., Puly Caff or a similar descaling agent) according to the cleaner's instructions. This helps remove stubborn coffee oils and mineral deposits. Rinse thoroughly after soaking.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the filter for any signs of damage, deformation, or excessive clogging that cannot be cleaned. Replace the filter if it is damaged.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Slow Extraction / Clogging:** If coffee flows too slowly or not at all, the filter holes may be clogged, or the coffee grind is too fine. Clean the filter thoroughly. Adjust grind size if necessary.

- **Fast Extraction / Weak Coffee:** If coffee flows too quickly, the coffee grind may be too coarse, or not enough coffee was used. Ensure proper tamping.
- **Filter Not Seating Properly:** Ensure there is no coffee residue or debris preventing the filter from sitting flush in the portafilter. Check for any deformation of the filter.
