USER MANUAL

Introduction

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your PDP Afterglow AGU.50 Wired Headset. Designed for multi-platform compatibility, this headset offers clear audio and communication for an enhanced gaming experience.

Setup

Follow these steps to connect your Afterglow AGU.50 headset to your gaming system or PC.

1. **Attach the Microphone:** Insert the flexible microphone into the designated port on the left earcup until it clicks securely into place. Ensure the microphone is oriented correctly for optimal voice pickup.
2. **Connect to Your Device:**
 - **For Xbox 360, PlayStation 3, and Wii U:** Connect the headset's 3.5mm audio jack to the appropriate audio output port on your console or TV. For chat functionality, additional console-specific adapters (not included) may be required depending on your console model and setup.
 - **For PC Gaming:** Connect the headset's 3.5mm audio jack to your computer's audio output (green port) and microphone input (pink port) if your PC has separate jacks. If your PC has a single combined audio jack, you may need a Y-splitter adapter (not included).
3. **Power On (if applicable):** The headset is wired and does not require separate power. Ensure your console or PC is powered on.

Operation

Understanding the controls and features of your headset.

1. **Adjusting the Headset:** Extend or retract the headband to fit comfortably over your head. The earcups are designed to pivot for a snug fit.
2. **In-line Controls:** The headset features an in-line control unit on the cable for easy access to audio adjustments.
 - **Master Volume Dial:** Rotate the dial to increase or decrease the overall audio volume.
 - **Game/Chat Balance (if supported by console/PC setup):** Some setups allow for separate adjustment of game audio and chat volume. Refer to your console or PC's audio settings for configuration.
 - **Microphone Mute Switch:** Use the switch to quickly mute or unmute your microphone.
3. **Microphone Usage:** Position the flexible microphone approximately 1-2 inches from your mouth for optimal voice clarity. The noise-cancelling feature helps reduce background noise.
4. **Afterglow Illumination:** The earcups feature blue LED illumination, which activates when the headset is connected and receiving power through the audio jack.

Maintenance

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your headset.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the headset. For earcups, a slightly damp cloth with mild soap can be used, but ensure no moisture enters the speaker grilles. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid

wrapping the cable too tightly to prevent damage.

- **Microphone Care:** When not in use, the microphone can be detached and stored separately to prevent bending or damage.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your headset, refer to the following common solutions.

Problem	Solution
No audio from headset.	Ensure the 3.5mm audio jack is fully inserted into the correct port on your device. Check the master volume dial on the in-line control unit and increase the volume. Verify your device's audio output settings are configured to send audio to the headset. Test the headset on another device to rule out a device-specific issue.
Microphone is not working.	Ensure the microphone is securely attached to the headset. Check that the microphone mute switch on the in-line control unit is in the 'unmuted' position. Verify your device's microphone input settings are configured correctly and the microphone volume is not set to zero. For PC, ensure you are using a Y-splitter if your PC has separate audio/mic jacks.
Experiencing static or poor audio quality.	Ensure all connections are secure and free from debris. Try connecting the headset to a different audio port or device to check for interference. Avoid placing the cable near sources of electromagnetic interference.


